Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

Table Skirt

Materials You Will Need:

6 yards of lime/purple dot

1. Fold each short edge of the fabric over 1/4" and fold over again to make a double hem. Stitch in place. Repeat along one long side of the fabric.
2. If you have a ruffle foot, set the stitch length to 2 and the foot to 1, stitch along the remaining long edge. Note: If you don't have a ruffle foot, use long basting stitches. If you do not have a ruffle foot, sew two long basting stitches along the raw edge.
3. Gently pull the threads at both ends of the ruffle stitch to gather the table skirt. When the gather is as tight as possible, creating a circular table skirt, secure the ends. Lay the skirt over the table with the gathered area in the center and cover with the quilt.

Napkins

(Makes 4 - 19" square napkins)

Materials You Will Need:

1 yard of lime/purple dot

Cutting Directions:

From the lime/purple dot, cut:
(4) 20" squares

1. Fold one edge of a square over 1/4" and fold over again to make a double hem. Stitch in place. Repeat along remaining three sides of square. (Make 4)
