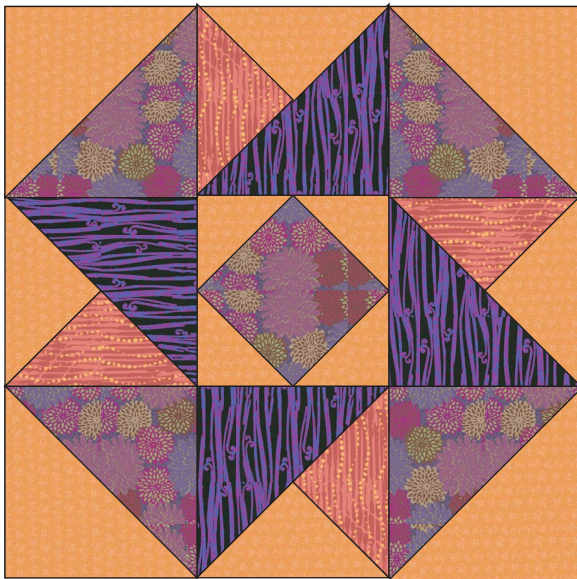


Fabric Stash Blocks

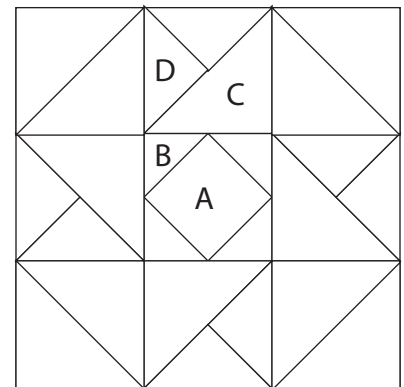



Air Castle - 12"

My moods change and I don't always want to work with bright, perky colors. I've picked these fabrics because they make me think of places that have been around for hundreds of years. They are destined for traditional patterns with an old world charm for quilts I will enjoy for years to come.


Textura Grafica (Baum Textiles) is a collection by Yolanda Fundora with Barbara Campbell Inspired by Italian textiles. These four fabrics give me a sense that they are here to stay. The florals are rich and deep but not too big so I can work with the flowers in the size they are. Three supporting fabrics lend a feeling of excitement with irregular vertical "squiggles" and small dashed lines.

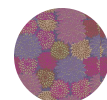
