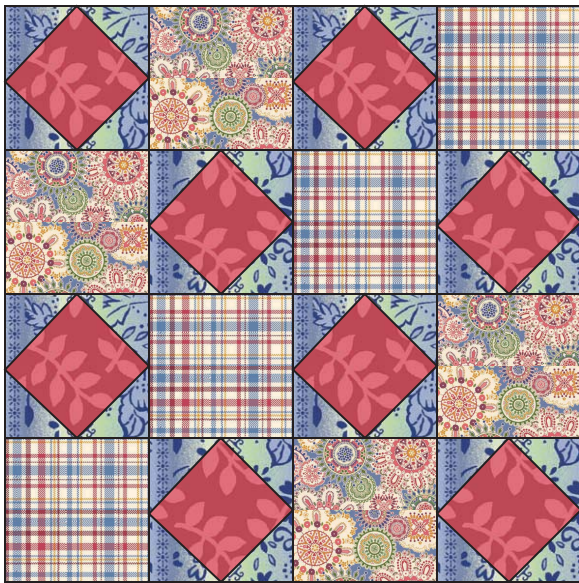


Fabric Stash Blocks

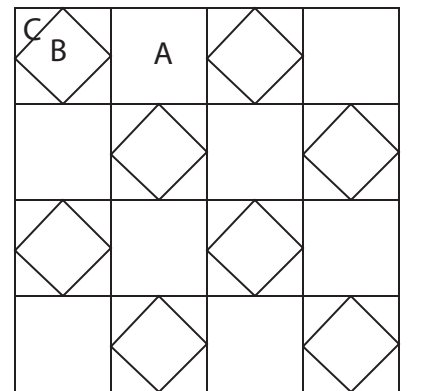
Squares & Diamonds - 12"
