




Spying on the Sky

They're both beautifully represented in Timeless Treasures' "Nature/Outdoors Collection" and are set off splendidly by butter and turquoise solids from their "Java Blenders" line. I love seeing the many-colored butterflies against black and the delicate dragonflies against cobalt blue- it's as if I'm looking through a telescope that sees at night. The complementary colors yellow and blue, from opposite sides of the color wheel, intensify each other and create drama, the same way opposite personalities attract.

- B  Cut two blue and two yellow (template on next page)
- Br  Cut two blue and two yellow (template on next page)
- C  Cut one 5-3/8" square of blue & yellow; recut into two triangles each
