







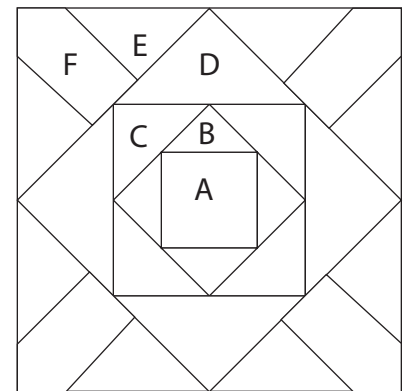
As The World Turns ...

These are about the most blendable fabrics I've ever seen and work together to make a strong, yet soothing block, playing gold and green against warm, yet muted red, and setting off the brownish leaves. Pulling it all together is the print called "Harvest Time," with glowing red berries in bunches, hanging from changing leaves. Made into a quilt, it would invite me to snuggle up in front of the woodstove, savoring the prettiest season of all.

- B  Cut (1) 4-1/4" brown print
- C  Cut (2) 3-7/8" of gold print
- D  Cut (1) 7-1/4" green leaf print
- E  Cut (2) 5-1/4" gold print
- F  Cut (4) burgundy print (template on next page)

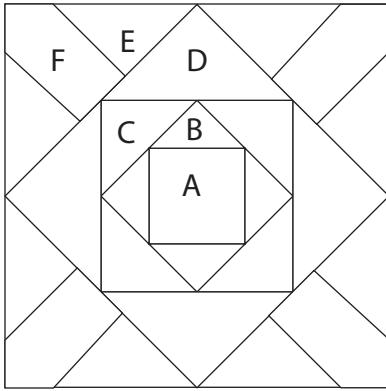
