


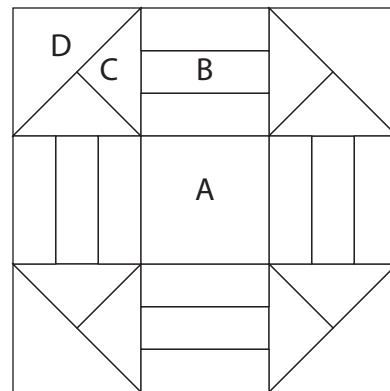
Shakespeare In Love (1998)
