


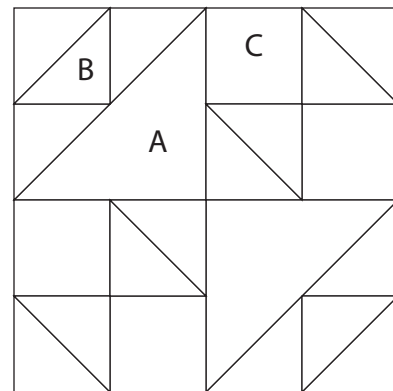
The Thorn Birds (1983)

Originally a TV mini-series telling the dramatic story of a family who emigrates to Australia during the early part of the 20th century. They trek to the outback to live on a "Station," raising sheep and the family fortunes. This complex saga takes you from their arrival to the next generation. Fabrics from M & S Textiles, designed by native Australians, depict the symbols and colors important to Aboriginal culture and give a sense of how remote and different was the land the settlers took over. M & S Fabrics portray kangaroos jumping, snakes slithering and all kinds of symbolic images. The fabrics are intricately patterned and great fun to sew.

- A**  Cut (1) 6-7/8" red print; recut into two triangles
- B**  Cut (4) 3-7/8" black swirl print, (1) 3-7/8" red print and (3) 3-7/8" green print; recut into two triangles each
- C**  Cut (4) 3-1/2" brown print
