

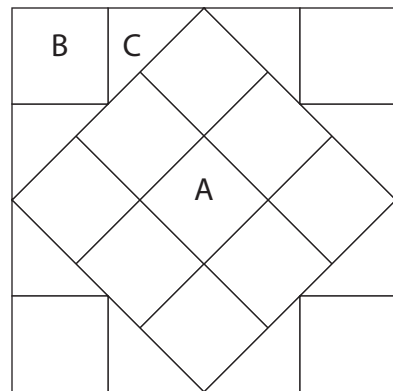


Barefoot in the Grass

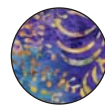

## Art Square Nine Patch - 12"

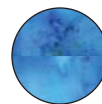
- A**  Cut (4) 3-3/8" pink butterfly print

- C**  Cut (4) 3-7/8" red print



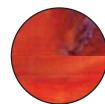
