


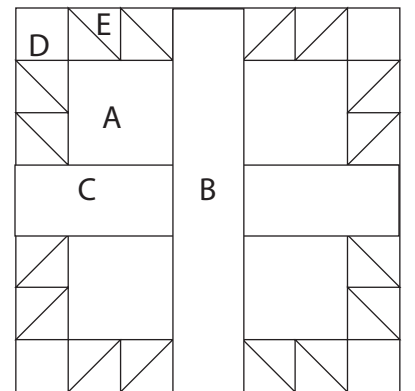

- D  Cut (4) 2-1/2" red print
- E  Cut (8) 2-7/8" blue/black print
