

Marie's Garden Pillow Roll

Materials You Will Need:

- 1/2 yard of pink print
- 1/2 yard of red lantern print
- 1/4 yard of stripe print
- (1) Fairfield™ 9" x 14" neck roll pillow form

Cutting Directions:

From the pink print, cut:

- (1) 4-1/2" x 28-1/2" strip
- (2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips

From the red lantern print, cut:

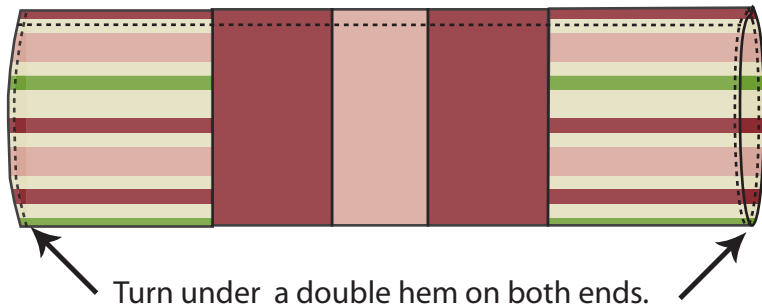
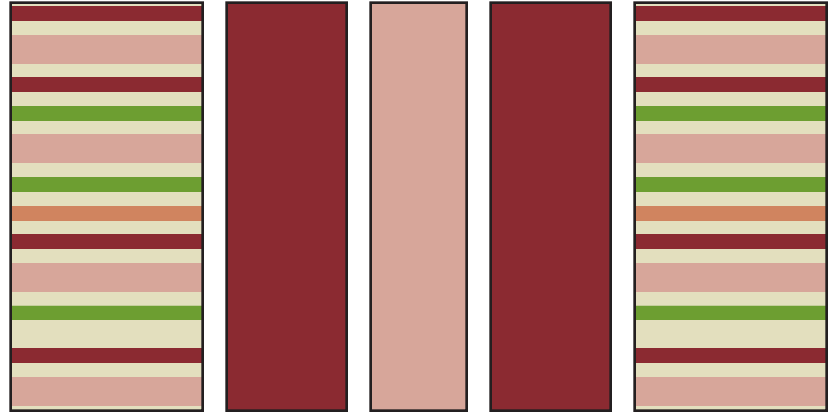
- (2) 5-1/2" x 28-1/2" strips (fussy cut print to same orientation)

From the stripe print, cut:

- (2) 8-1/2" x 28-1/2" strips (fussy cut so stripes are horizontal)

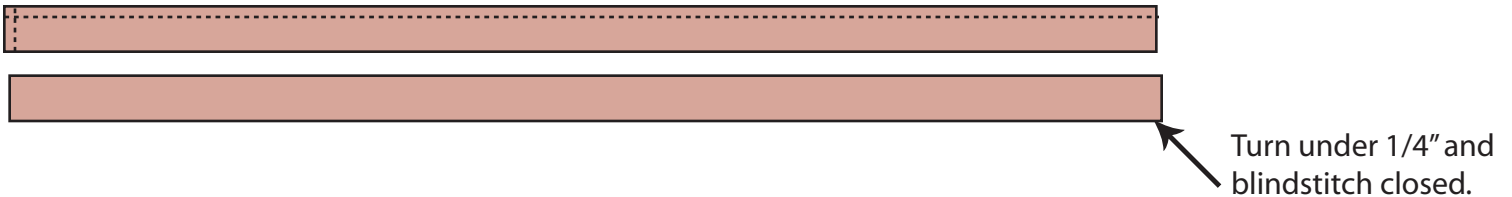
Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

Stitch a 5-1/2" red lantern strip to both sides of the 4-1/2" pink strip. Stitch a 8-1/2" strip of striped fabric to both 5-1/2" red lantern strips creating a 5-strip panel.



Fold the fabric in half widthwise, with right sides together, matching seams. Stitch along the long edge. Turn under 1/4" on the tube ends and press. Turn under another 1/4" on the tube ends to form a double hem. Topstitch the hem in place. Turn right side out.

Fold a 2-1/2" x 42" pink strip in half lengthwise, right sides together. Stitch on one short end and on the long edge. Turn the strip right side out and press. Turn in 1/4" on the open end and press. Blindstitch the open end closed. (Make 2 ties)



Insert the pillow form. Close each end with a tie, tying it into a bow.
