Materials You Will Need:

Kwik-Sew pattern #2997 (available from www.kwiksew.com)

3 yards of cording for front flap

Additional Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. To make the flowers, cut large flowers from the daisy fabric, then layer them with batting and backing. Use a satin stitch along the flower edges and outline-stitch around each petal to quilt them.
2. Pin the flowers on the flap, then outline the flower center with decorative stitches to attach it to the bag. If you want the flowers to be removable, attach them with Velcro® coins. To make bag washable, use Timtec as stiffener in the base, because it adds lots of body while still being washable.
