Table Runner

Materials You Will Need:

- 1/2 yard of a brown solid
- 3/8 yard of a brown check print
- 1/4 yard of a white with brown dot print
- 1/4 yard of the Kitschy Chicky brown print
- 1/8 yard of a brown paisley print
- Fat Quarter each of a medium light gold print and a brown with white dot print
- Fat Eighth each of a white alphabet print and a white with brown ticking stripe print
- 15" x 54" piece of backing
- 15" x 54" piece of batting
- Fusible web

Cutting Directions:

From the brown solid print, cut:

- (4) 2-1/4" x 42" strips

From the brown check print, cut:

- (2) 2" x 40-1/2" strips
- (6) 1" x 10-1/2" strips
- (4) 2" x 9" strips

From the white with brown dot print, cut:

- (1) 1-1/2" x 42" strip
- (4) 2-1/2" squares and (4) Template A pieces

From the Kitschy Chicky brown print, cut:

- (1) 3-1/2" chicken motif square, fussy cut to center
- (1) 3-1/2" label motif square, fussy cut to center

From the brown paisley print, cut:

- (1) 1-1/2" x 42" strip

From the medium light gold print, cut:

- (2) 10-1/2" squares

From the brown with white dot print, cut:

- (8) Template B pieces
- (8) Template B-reverse pieces

From the white alphabet print, cut:

- (1) 7-3/4" square, then cut in half once diagonally
- (1) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle

From the white with brown ticking stripe, cut

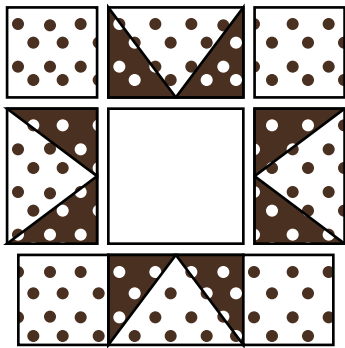
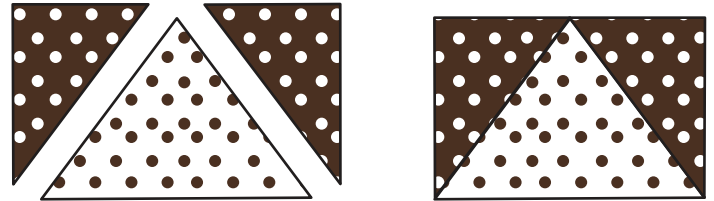
- (1) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle

Sewing Directions:

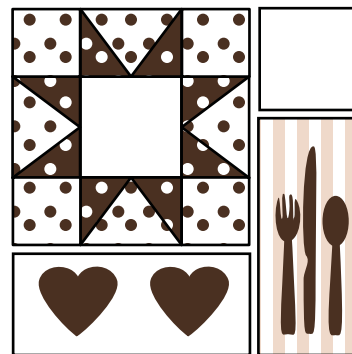
(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace (1) chicken, (1) rooster, (4) hearts, and (1) set of silverware onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape and press to the backside of the fusible web. Cut out each shape and press to the back side of the brown solid.
2. Press the chicken onto (1) 10-1/2" medium light gold print square. Press the rooster onto the other 10-1/2" medium gold print square.
3. Following the table runner photo as a reference, center (2) brown solid hearts onto (1) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" white alphabet print rectangle. Press the set of silverware onto (1) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" white with brown ticking stripe.
4. Finish the raw edges on all the appliques with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.

5. Sew (1) brown with white dot print Template B and (1) Template B-reversed to each side of (1) white with brown dot print Template A. (Make 4 flying geese units)

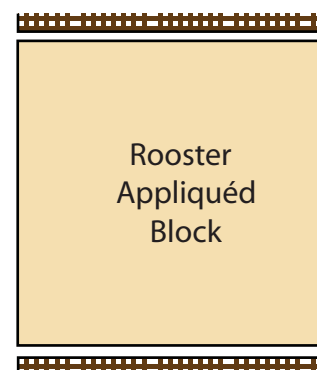
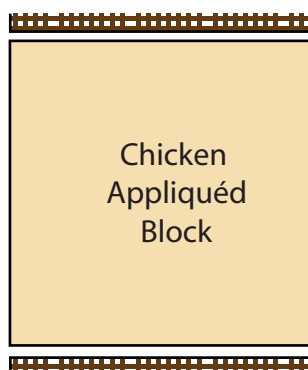
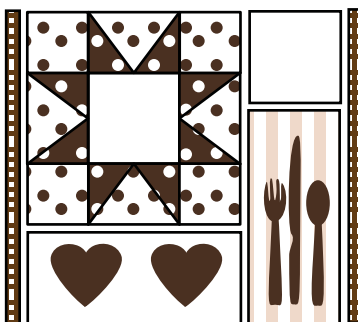


6. Sew a flying geese unit to the two sides of (1) 3-1/2" Kitschy Chicky brown print square. Sew a 2-1/2" white with brown dot print square to each end of the remaining (2) flying geese units. Sew these pieced units to the top and bottom of the 3-1/2" square to make the pieced block.

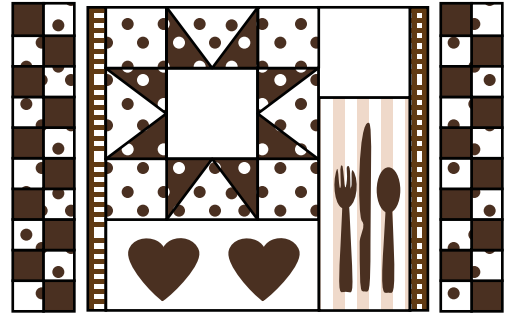
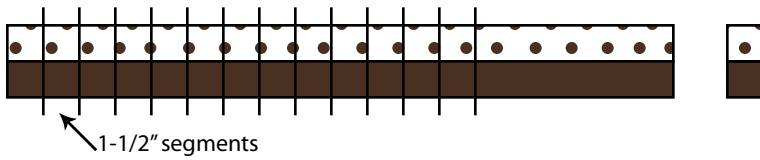


7. Sew the double heart appliqué block to the bottom of the pieced block.
8. Sew (1) 3-1/2" label motif square to the top of (1) silverware block. Sew this unit to the right side of the pieced block.

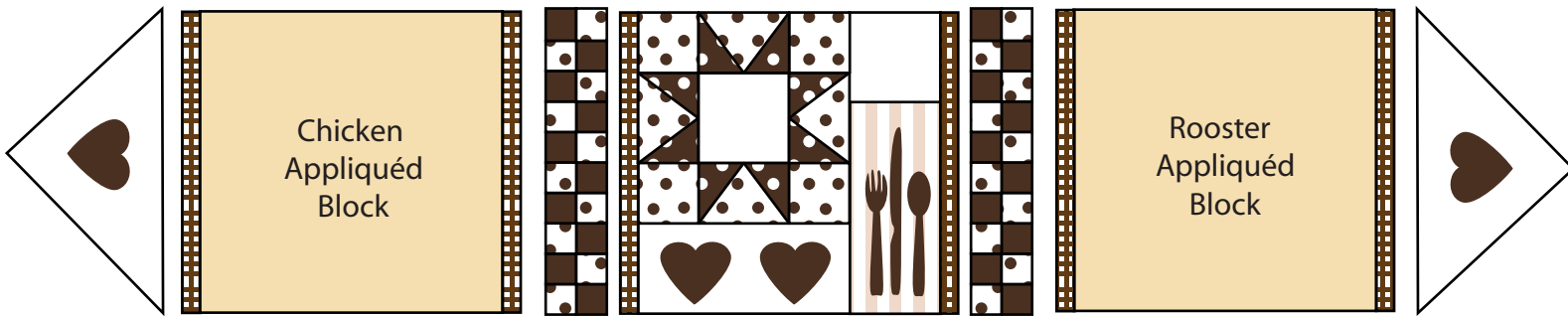
9. Sew a 1" x 10-1/2" brown check strip to the sides of the pieced block and to the top and bottom of the chicken appliqué block and to the top and bottom of the rooster appliqué block.



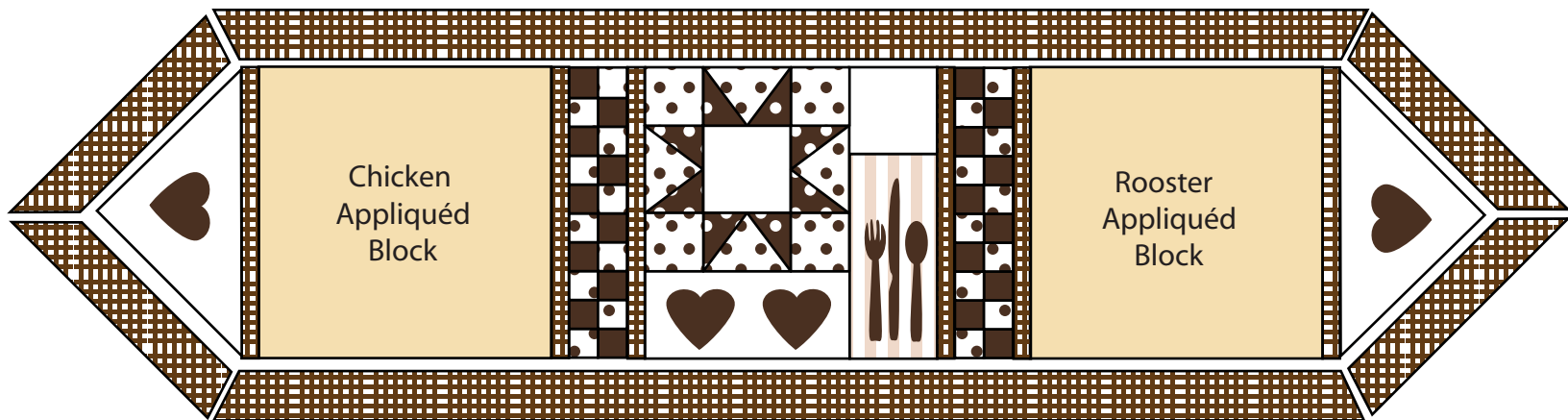
10. For the checkerboard sashing, sew (1) 1-1/2" x 42" brown paisley print strip to (1) 1-1/2" x 42" white with brown dot print strip. Crosscut the strip into (20) 1-1/2" segments. Sew together (10) 1-1/2" segments to make a checkerboard sashing unit. (Make 2) Sew a checkerboard sashing unit to each side of the pieced block.



11. Following the table runner photo for placement, sew the rooster block and the chicken block to the pieced block to make the table runner. Sew (1) white alphabet print triangle to each end of the table runner.



12. Sew (1) 2" x 40-1/2" brown check print strip to the top and bottom of the table runner. Sew (1) 2" x 9" brown check print strip to each side of the setting triangle. Miter corners as needed.



13. Layer, quilt and use the (4) 2-1/4" x 42" brown solid strips to bind the quilt..

Placemats (Makes 2)

Materials You Will Need:

1/2 yard of a brown solid
1/4 yard of a brown check print
1/4 yard of a white with brown dot print
Fat Quarter of a medium light gold print
Fat Eighth each of a white alphabet print and a white with brown ticking stripe print,
and a brown paisley print
15" x 40" piece of backing
15" x 54" piece of batting
Fusible web

Cutting Directions:

From the brown solid print, cut:

(4) 2-1/4" x 42" strips

From the brown check print, cut:

(4) 2" x 15-1/2" strips

(4) 2" x 13-1/2" strips

From the white with brown dot print, cut:

(1) 1-1/2" x 42" strip

From the brown paisley print, cut:

(1) 1-1/2" x 42" strip

From the medium light gold print, cut:

(2) 10-1/2" squares

From the white alphabet print, cut:

(2) 3-1/2" squares

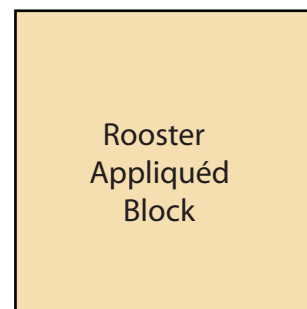
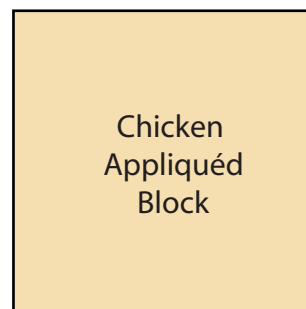
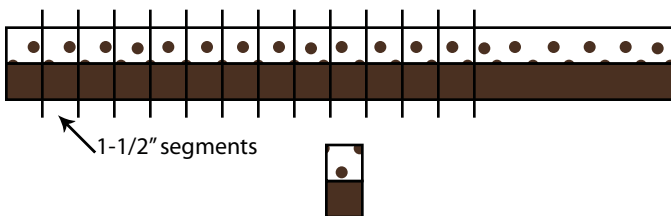
From the white with brown ticking stripe, cut

(2) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles

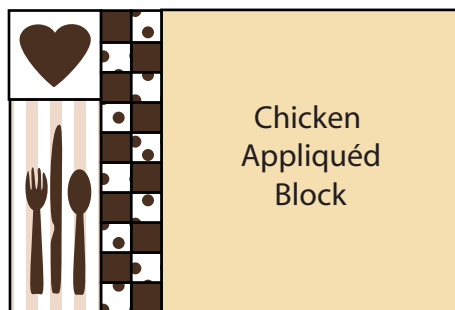
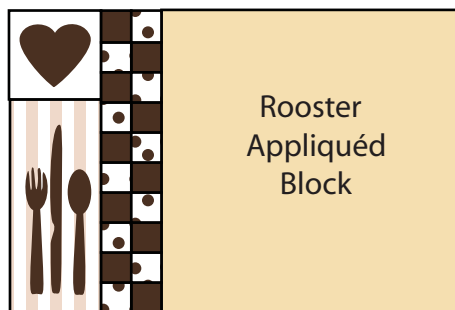
Sewing Directions:

(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)

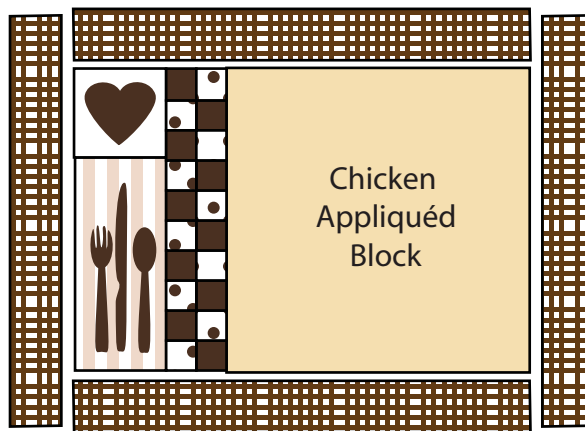
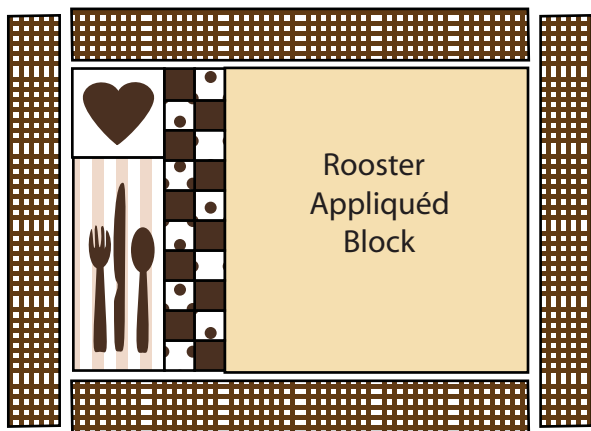
1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace (1) chicken, (1) rooster, (2) hearts, and (2) sets of silverware onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape and press to the backside of the fusible web. Cut out each shape and press to the back side of the brown solid.
2. Press the chicken onto (1) 10-1/2" medium light gold print square. Press the rooster onto the other 10-1/2" medium gold print square.
3. Following the placemat photo as a reference, center a brown solid heart onto (1) 3-1/2" white alphabet print square. (Make 2) Press the set of silverware onto (1) 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" white with brown ticking stripe. (Make 2)
4. Finish the raw edges on all the appliques with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
5. For the checkerboard sashing, sew (1) 1-1/2" x 42" brown paisley print strip to (1) 1-1/2" x 42" white with brown dot print strip. Crosscut the strip into (20) 1-1/2" segments. Sew together (10) 1-1/2" segments to make a checkerboard sashing unit. (Make 2) Sew a checkerboard sashing unit to the left side of the chicken block and to the left side of the rooster block.



8. Sew (1) 3-1/2" heart square to the top of (1) silverware block. (Make 2)
Sew these units to the left side of the rooster and chicken blocks.



9. Sew (1) 2" x 40-1/2" brown check print strip to the top and bottom of the table runner. Sew (1) 2" x 9" brown check print strip to each side of the setting triangle. Miter corners as needed.



10. Layer, quilt and use the (4) 2-1/4" x 42" brown solid strips to bind the quilt..
