

My Heart Comes Home Pillow

“My Heart Comes Home” quilt patterned in
February/March 2008 issue of QUILT Magazine

Materials You Will Need:

1/2 yard of a framed house print panel
3/4 yard of pink polka dot print
Fiberfill

Cutting Directions:

From the framed house print, cut:
(9) 5-1/2" x 5-3/4" house rectangles, fussy cut
to center four framed houses and allowing
a 1/4" seam allowance on all sides

From the pink polka dot print, cut:
(1) 22" x 22-3/4" rectangle
(2) 3" x 17-3/4" strips
(2) 3" x 22" strips

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Layout the framed house rectangles into 3 rows of 3 rectangles each. Sew the rectangles together within each row. Join the rows to make the pillow front.
2. Stitch the (2) 3" x 17-3/4" strips to the sides of the pillow front. Stitch the 3" x 22" strips to the top and bottom of the pillow front.
3. With right sides together, place the 22" x 22-3/4" pink polka dot rectangle on the pillow front. Sew a seam around all four sides leaving a 6" opening at the bottom of the pillow for stuffing. Turn the pillow right side out and press.
4. Before stuffing, sew in the ditch of the pink polka dot border seam through all layers to create the flange leaving the 6" opening unsewn. Stuff the pillow using the fiberfill. Finish sewing the 6" opening on the flange. Hand sew the 6" opening on the back closed.
