Web Bonus patterns for pillow roll

Materials You Will Need:

3/4 yard of a small medium blue print
5/8 yard of a large navy paisley print
1/3 yard of a navy stripe print
(1) 26" long neck roll pillow form

Cutting Directions:

From the small medium blue print, cut:
(2) 18" x 24-1/2" rectangles

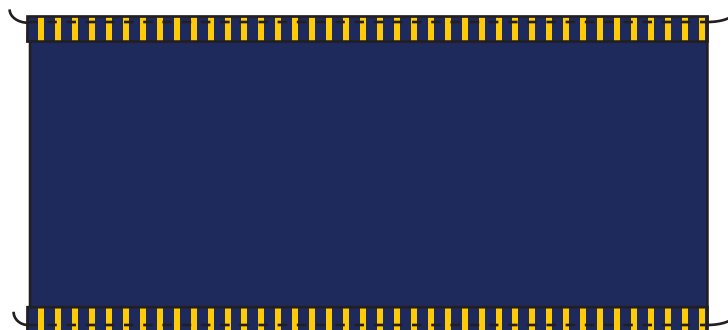
From the navy paisley print, cut:
(1) 12" x 24-1/2" rectangle
(2) 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips

From the navy stripe print, cut:
(2) 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips
(2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips

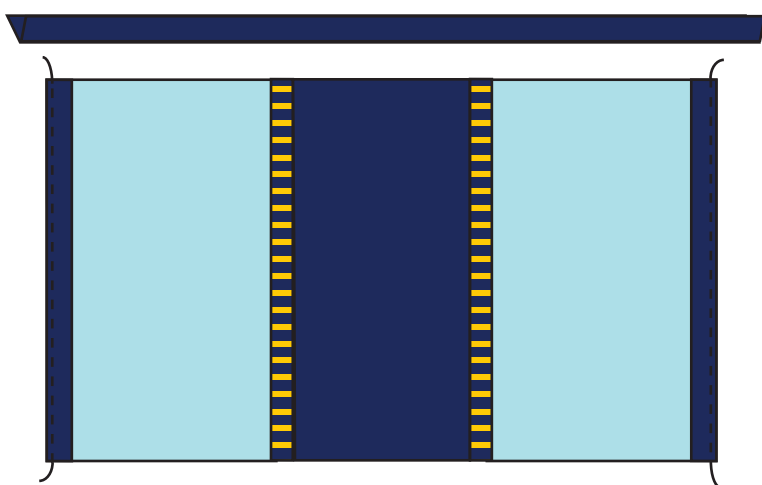
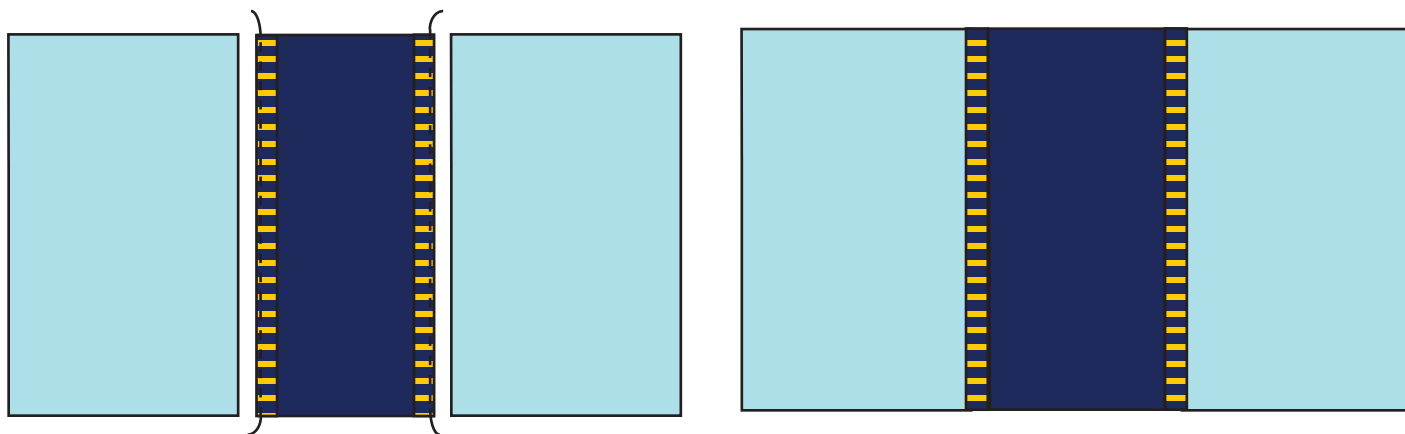
Sewing Directions:

(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)

1. Fold the (2) 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" navy stripe print strips in half, wrong sides together lengthwise, and press. Baste them, raw edges together, to the long sides of the 12" x 24-1/2" navy paisley print rectangle, as shown.

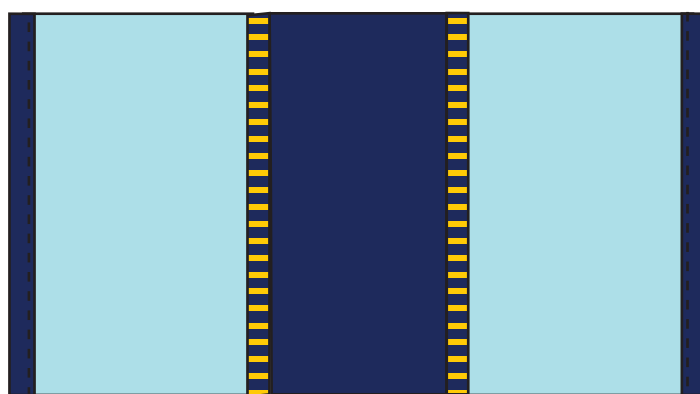


2. Stitch the 12" x 24-1/2" navy paisley print rectangle in between (2) 18" x 24-1/2" small medium blue print rectangles, as shown. Press seams toward the navy so the stripe print lays away from the navy.



3. Fold the (2) 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" navy paisley print strips in half, wrong sides together lengthwise, and press. Stitch each to a long side of the 18" x 24-1/2" small medium blue print rectangle, as shown.

4. Press the seams toward the medium blue print so the navy paisley print lays away from the medium blue. Topstitch the seam close to the edge.



5. Fold the pillow cover in half, right sides together lengthwise and stitch the long edge to make a long roll. Turn right side out. Insert pillow form and center inside the roll.

6. To make the ties, fold the (2) 2-1/2" x 42" navy stripe strips in half, right sides together lengthwise, and sew on three sides, leaving a short end open to turn. Turn the tie right side out and press. Gather the tail of the pillow roll on one end and tie a bow using a tie strip. Adjust the tie length to fit as you please. Trim any excess length from the tie on the unsewn short end. When the tie is the length you desire, tuck in 1/4" on the unsewn end and hand stitch closed. Trim and handsew the second tie to the same length. Tie to pillow roll.
