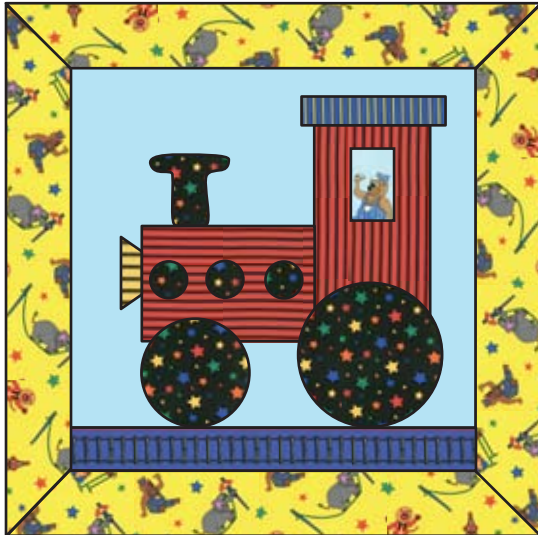


Fabric Stash Blocks

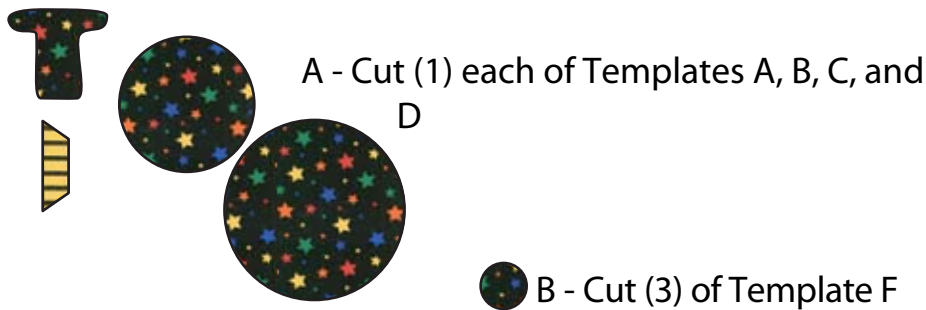

12" CIRCUS TRAIN

In 1872, the Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey Circus had grown so large that they decided to travel by train. The train often was more than a mile in length. Bringing the circus to small towns all across America, was the delight of every child eagerly waiting to see the elephants, clowns and acrobats! 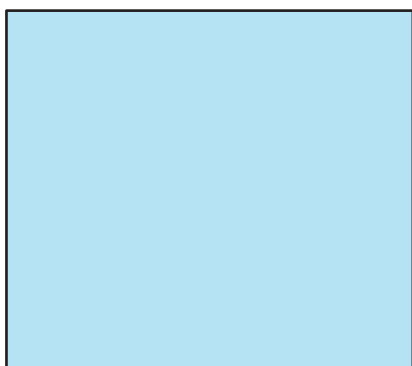
C - Cut (1) 2-5/8" x 5-1/4" piece



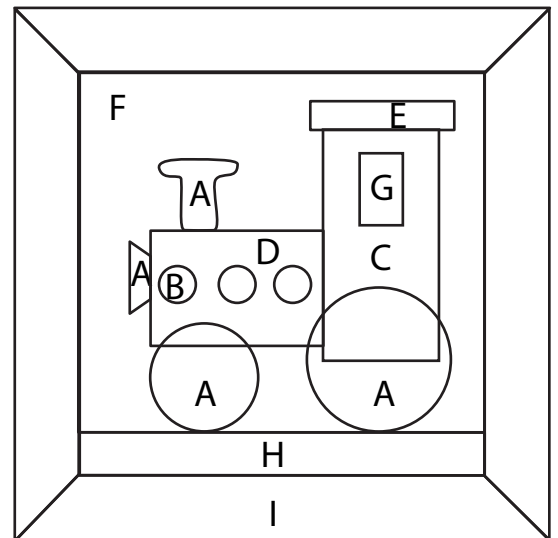
D - Cut (1) 2-5/8" x 4" piece



E - Cut (1) 5/8" x 3-1/4" piece for roof



F - Cut (1) 8-1/2" x 9-1/2" piece for background



G - Cut (1) 1" x 1-5/8" piece, fussy cut to feature the bear



H - Cut (1) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" piece, fussy cut to center track



I - Cut (4) 2" x 15" pieces (extra length for mitering the corners)

*Appliqués shown without seam allowance for fusible appliqué. Add 1/4" seam allowance for needle-turn method.
