## Pillow Roll

### Materials You Will Need:

- 1/8 yard each of (4) bright fabrics
- 1/2 yard of a black fabric
- 1 yard each of (4) assorted trims
- 1 Fairfield 5” x 14” neck roll pillow form

### Cutting Directions:

From each of the bright fabrics, cut:  
(2) 1” x 18” strips

From only (3) of the bright fabrics, cut from each:  
(1) 1” x 20-1/2” strip

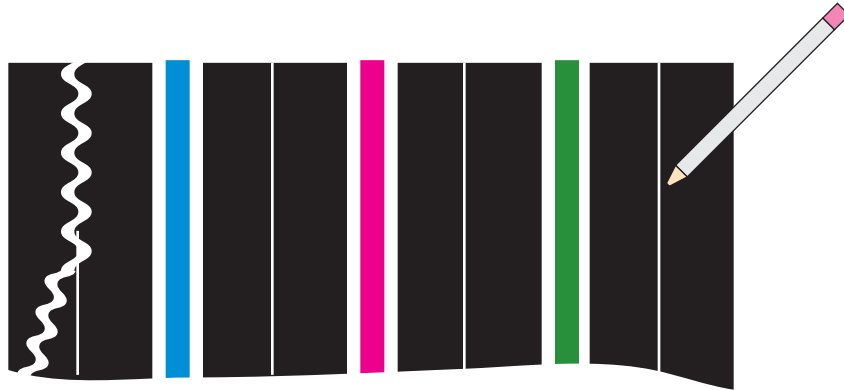
From the black fabric, cut:  
(2) 8-1/2” x 20-1/2” strips  
(4) 3-1/2” x 20-1/2” strips

### Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4” unless stated otherwise)*

1. Stitch a 1” x 20-1/2” bright fabric strip in between each 3-1/2” x 20-1/2” black strip, as shown.



2. Mark the middle of each 3-1/2" x 20-1/2" strip with a water soluble pencil. Place one piece of trim on each strip and stitch. If using the lacing, mark the design you'd like to make with the water soluble pencil and zigzag stitch the lacing down as you go along, following the marking line. Trim each of the trims even with the pillow case.



3. Sew (1) 8-1/2" x 20-1/2" strip to both ends of the center panel.
4. Fold the center panel, right sides together, in half lengthwise and stitch. Hem the ends and turn right side out.
5. Fold each 1-1/2" x 18" strip of bright fabric in half, right sides together, lengthwise and stitch on one long end and one short end. Pull each strip through, so that the right side of the fabric is showing. Fold the raw edge of the one end under, press, and stitch closed. Insert pillow form. Tie each bright fabric strip on individually then tie them all together to form a large knot.

## Pillow Shams

### Materials You Will Need:

1-3/4 yards of bright pink fabric  
1/2 yard of a black fabric  
1 roll of pink lacing  
2-1/2 yards of lining fabric (optional)

### Cutting Directions:

From the bright pink fabric, cut:  
(2) 20-1/2" squares  
(2) 20-1/2" x 29" rectangles

From the black fabric, cut:  
(4) 4-3/4" x 20-1/2" strips

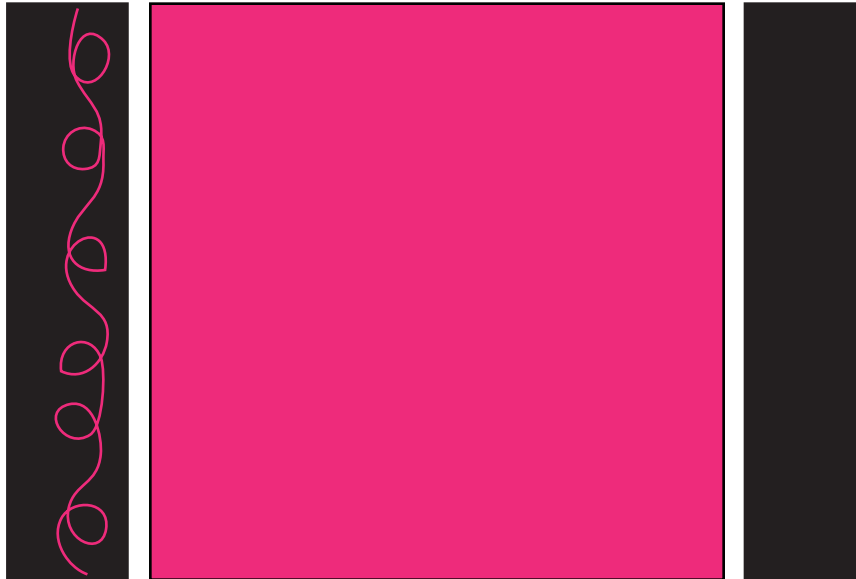
From the lining fabric, cut:  
(4) 20-1/2" x 29" rectangles

## Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Mark the middle of a black 4-3/4" x 20-1/2" strip with a water soluble pencil. Mark the design you would like to make with the pink lacing, making sure to leave room for the hem on one edge. Place the lacing on top of the line and zigzag stitch in place as you follow your pattern. Trim the lacing even with black strip. (Make 2)



2. To make the pillow front, stitch (1) untrimmed 4-3/4" x 20-1/2" black fabric strip to one side of a 20-1/2" bright pink square. (Make 2) Stitch (1) trimmed 4-3/4" x 20-1/2" black fabric strip to the opposite end of the same bright pink square. (Make 2)



3. Pin a pillow front, right sides together, to a 20-1/2" x 29" bright pink rectangle. Stitch on three sides, leaving the opening on the side with the trim. Press 1/2" hem on trim strip. If not using lining, stitch the hem in place and repeat for second sham.

If using lining, place the lining fabric, right sides together, and stitch on three sides as before. Press over 1/2" hem on short side. Drop lining inside pillow sham, wrong sides together. Pin around the opening, matching the side seams, and stitch the hem.
