Materials You Will Need:

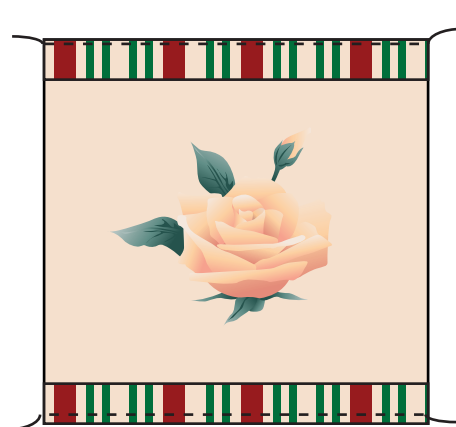
Fat quarter of a large rose print
1/2 yard of a dark red print, includes backing
Fat quarter of a stripe print
14" pillow form

Cutting Directions:

From the large rose print, cut:
(1) 9-1/2" square, fussy cut to center a flower motif
From the dark red print, cut:
(2) 3" x 9-1/2" strips
(2) 3" x 14-1/2" strips
(1) 14-1/2" square
From the stripe print, cut:
(4) 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Fold the (4) 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" stripe strips in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press to make the flange border.
2. Pin a flange border to the top and bottom of the 9-1/2" motif square. Baste in place using a 1/8" seam allowance. In the same manner, pin and baste the remaining flange borders to the two sides of the motif square. Stitch in place.



3. Stitch a 3" x 9-1/2" dark red strip to the top and bottom of the pillow front. Press away from center leaving flange pointing in to the center. In the same manner, stitch a 3" x 14-1/2" dark red strip to the sides of the pillow front. Press.



4. Sew the 14-1/2" dark red backing, with right sides together, to the pillow front on three sides, leaving one side open for the pillow form. Carefully trim the corners diagonally and turn pillow right side out. Insert pillow form and hand sew the opening closed.
