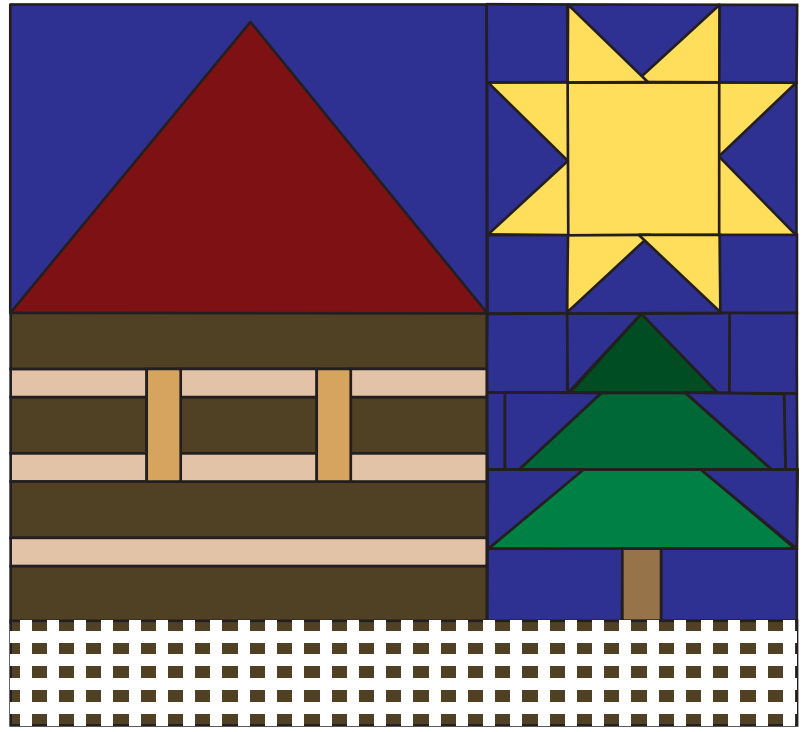


# Summer Camp Pillowcase

Web Bonus pattern for pillowcase

## Materials You Will Need:

8-1/2" x 16-1/2" red print rectangle (cabin roof)  
Fat eighth (9" x 22") brown print (cabin logs)  
1/8 yard tan print  
5" square gold (windows)  
2-1/2" x 4-1/2" green print #1 (tree top branch)  
2-1/2" x 6-1/2" green print #2 (middle tree branch)  
2-1/2" x 8-1/2" green print #3 (lower tree branch)  
1-1/2" x 2-1/2" brown print (tree trunk)  
1-1/2 yards blue star print  
1/4 yard gold print (star)  
1/4 yard brown check print  
1 yard brown print (lining)  
Queen size bed pillow  
28" x 67" piece of batting  
28" x 67" piece of muslin

## Cutting Directions:

For the Cabin block, cut:

- (4) 2-1/8" x 16-1/2" strips of brown print for the cabin logs
- (3) 1" x 16-1/2" strips of tan print for the mortar
- (2) 2-1/4" x 3-1/8" rectangles of gold for the windows
- (2) 8-1/2" squares of blue star print

For the Tree block, cut:

- (2) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips of blue star print for tree top background
- (2) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips of blue star print for the middle branch background
- (2) 2-1/2" squares blue star print for the lower branch background
- (2) 2-1/2" x 4" strips of blue star print for the tree trunk background

Also cut:

- (1) 26" x 34" rectangle of blue star print for the backing
- (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips of blue star print
- (4) 2-1/2" squares of blue star print
- (2) 4" x 16-1/2" strips of blue star print
- (1) 4" x 31-1/2" strip of blue star print
- (1) 4-1/2" square of gold print for star
- (8) 2-1/2" squares of gold print for star
- (1) 4" x 31-1/2" strip of brown check
- (2) 26" x 34" rectangles of brown print for lining

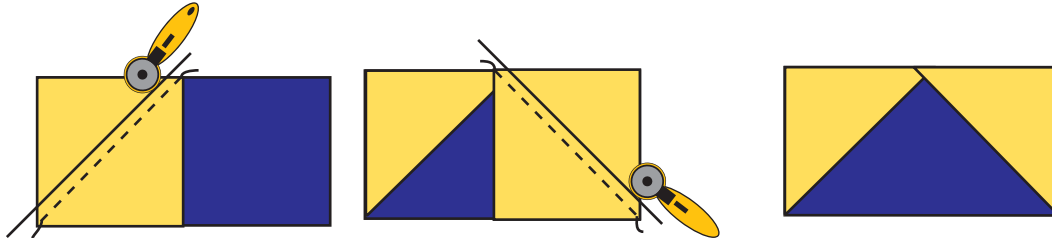
# Sewing Directions: (Makes 1 - 22" x 31" pillowcase)

(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)

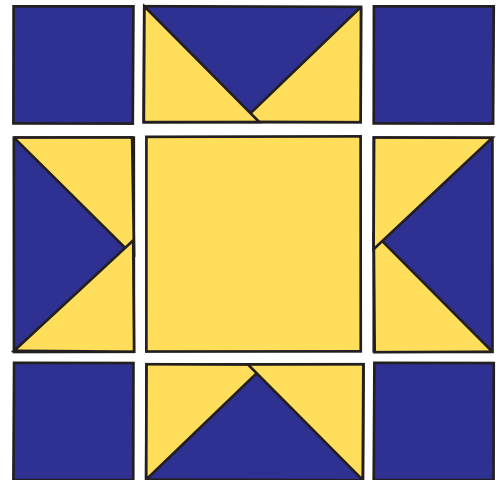
## 1. Star Block

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each 2-1/2" gold print square. Place a marked, gold print square, right sides together, on one end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blue star print rectangle. Stitch on the drawn line, as shown. Trim the seam allowance 1/4" beyond the stitching. Press open.

In the same manner, place a marked gold print square on the opposite end of the blue star print rectangle. Stitch on the marked line. Trim and press to complete a Flying Geese unit. (Make 4 Flying Geese units)



Using (4) 2-1/2" blue star print squares, (4) Flying Geese units, and (1) 4-1/2" gold print square, layout the Star Block, as shown. Stitch together the units in each row. Join the rows to make (1) 8" Star block.



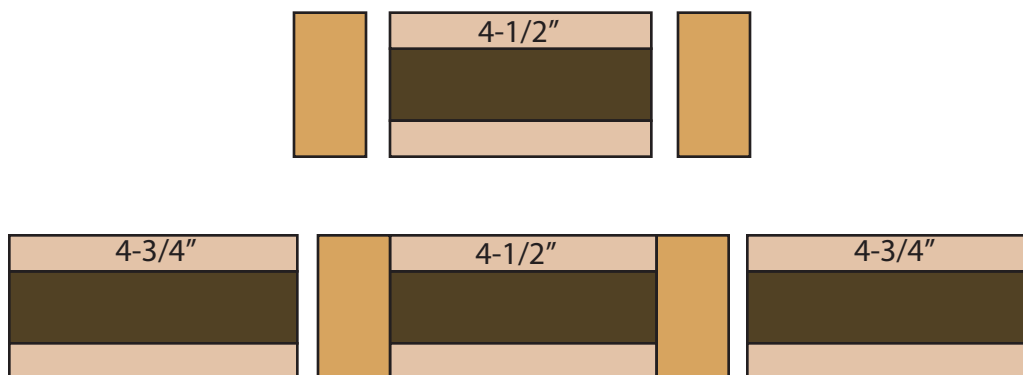
## 2. Cabin Block

In the same manner as above, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of an 8-1/2" blue star print square. Place the marked blue star print square, right sides together, on one end of an 8-1/2" x 16-1/2" red print rectangle. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance 1/4" beyond the stitching. Press open.

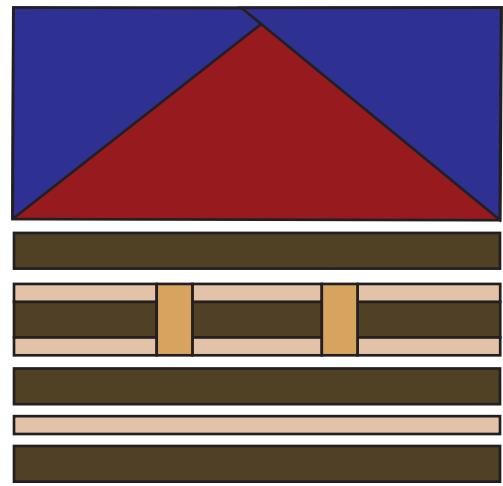
In the same manner, stitch an 8-1/2" dark blue print square to the opposite end of the red print rectangle. Trim and press, to make a roof piece.

Stitch a 2-1/8" x 16-1/2" brown print strip between (2) 1" x 16-1/2" tan print strips, to make a log unit.

From the log unit, cross-cut (1) 4-1/2" piece and (2) 4-3/4" pieces. Stitch the 4-1/2" piece between (2) 2-1/4" x 3-1/8" gold print rectangles to make a window unit. Stitch (2) 4-3/4" pieces to each end of a window unit, as shown. (Make a long window unit)



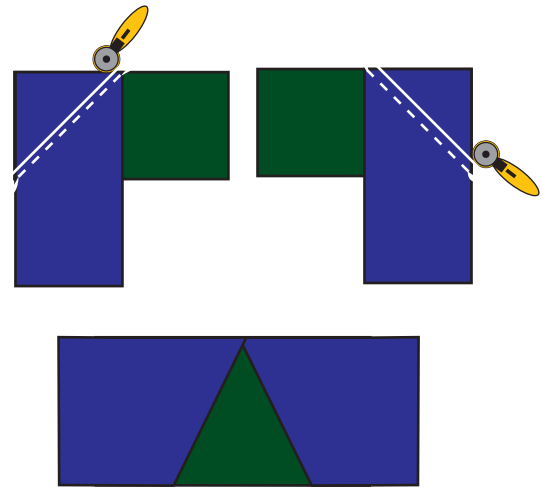
Refer to Cabin Block Layout; layout each of the rows in the cabin block vertically, as shown. Join the rows.  
Embroider a 3 x 4 grid on each window, if desired.



### 3. Tree Block

To make row 1, place a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blue star print rectangle on one end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" green print #1 rectangle, as shown, and stitch across the diagonal. Trim the seam allowance 1/4" beyond the stitching. Press open.

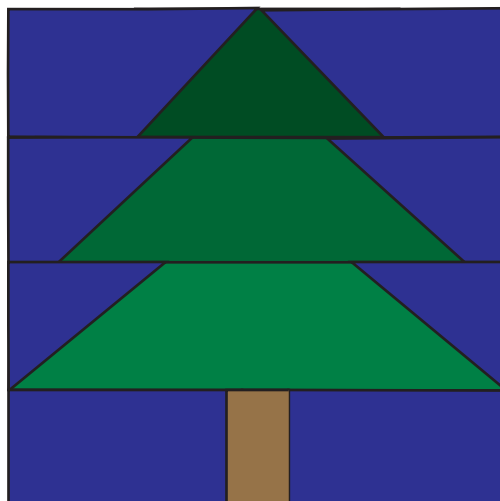
Place a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" blue star print rectangle on the opposite end of the green print #1 rectangle, as shown, and stitch across the diagonal. Trim and press.



To make row 2, in the same manner as row 1, stitch (2) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" blue star print rectangles to each end of a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" green print #2 rectangle. Trim and press open.

To make row 3, stitch (2) 2-1/2" blue star print squares to each end of a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" green print #3 rectangle. Trim and press open.

To make row 4, stitch a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" brown print rectangle between two 2-1/2" x 4" blue star print rectangles. Stitch the four rows together to make the Tree block.



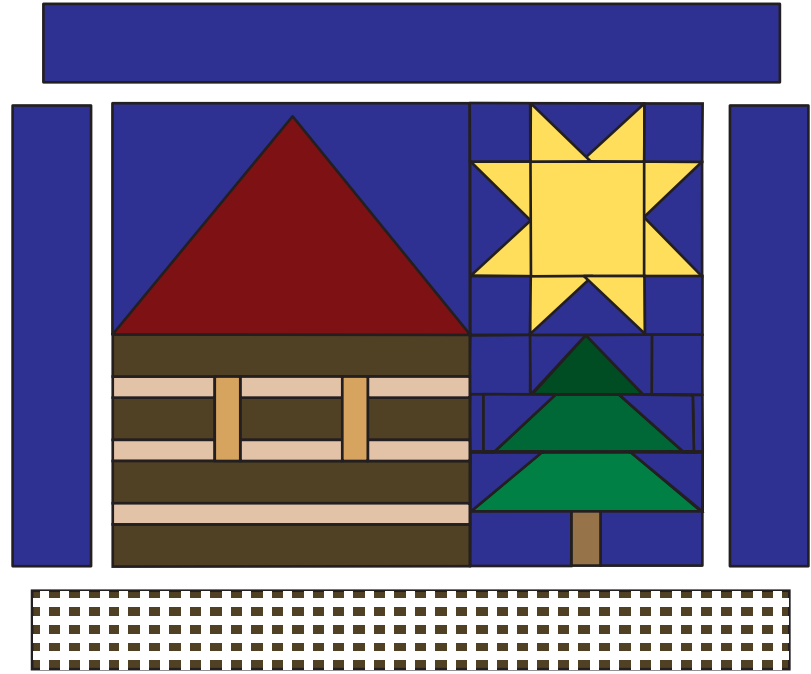
#### 4. Assembling the pillowcase

Stitch the Star block to the top of the Tree block.  
Stitch the Star/Tree unit to the side of the Cabin block.

Stitch the (2) 4" x 16-1/2" blue star strips to the short sides of the pillowcase.

Stitch the 4" x 31-1/2" blue star strip to the top of the pillowcase.

Stitch the 4" x 31-1/2" brown check strip to the bottom of the pillowcase.



Measure the width and length of the pillowcase. Trim the 26" x 34" blue star print rectangle and the (2) 26" x 34" brown print lining rectangles to that measurement. Set the brown print rectangles aside.

Stitch the trimmed blue star print rectangle to the pillowcase top, right sides together, along the left side. Open the unit and layer in this manner.

28" x 67" muslin rectangle

28" x 67" piece of batting

pillowcase top/backing unit, right side up

Quilt as desired.

Trim the muslin and batting even with the pillowcase top/backing. Stitch the lining rectangles, right sides together, along a short side leaving a 12" opening. Open the lining and place the pillowcase on top of the lining, right sides together. Stitch around the entire outside edge of the pillowcase top. Trim the lining even with edges of the pillowcase.

Turn pillowcase right side out through the lining opening and blind stitch the opening closed. Push the lining inside the pillowcase top. Insert the bed pillow.
