Materials You Will Need:

5/8 yard of a cream small sunflower print

3/8 yard of a large sunflower border print (or a leftover section from the border used in making the quilt)

Cutting Directions:

From the cream small sunflower print, cut:

(2) 12-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles

From the large sunflower border print, cut:

(1) 8" x 16-1/2" strip, fussy cut to center the flowered border print

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Stitch the 8" x 16-1/2" border strip in between the (2) 12-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles. With right sides together, sew the three sides of the pillow, leaving an opening for turning. Turn right side out, and press. Fill with fiberfill to desired fullness and stitch the opening closed.
