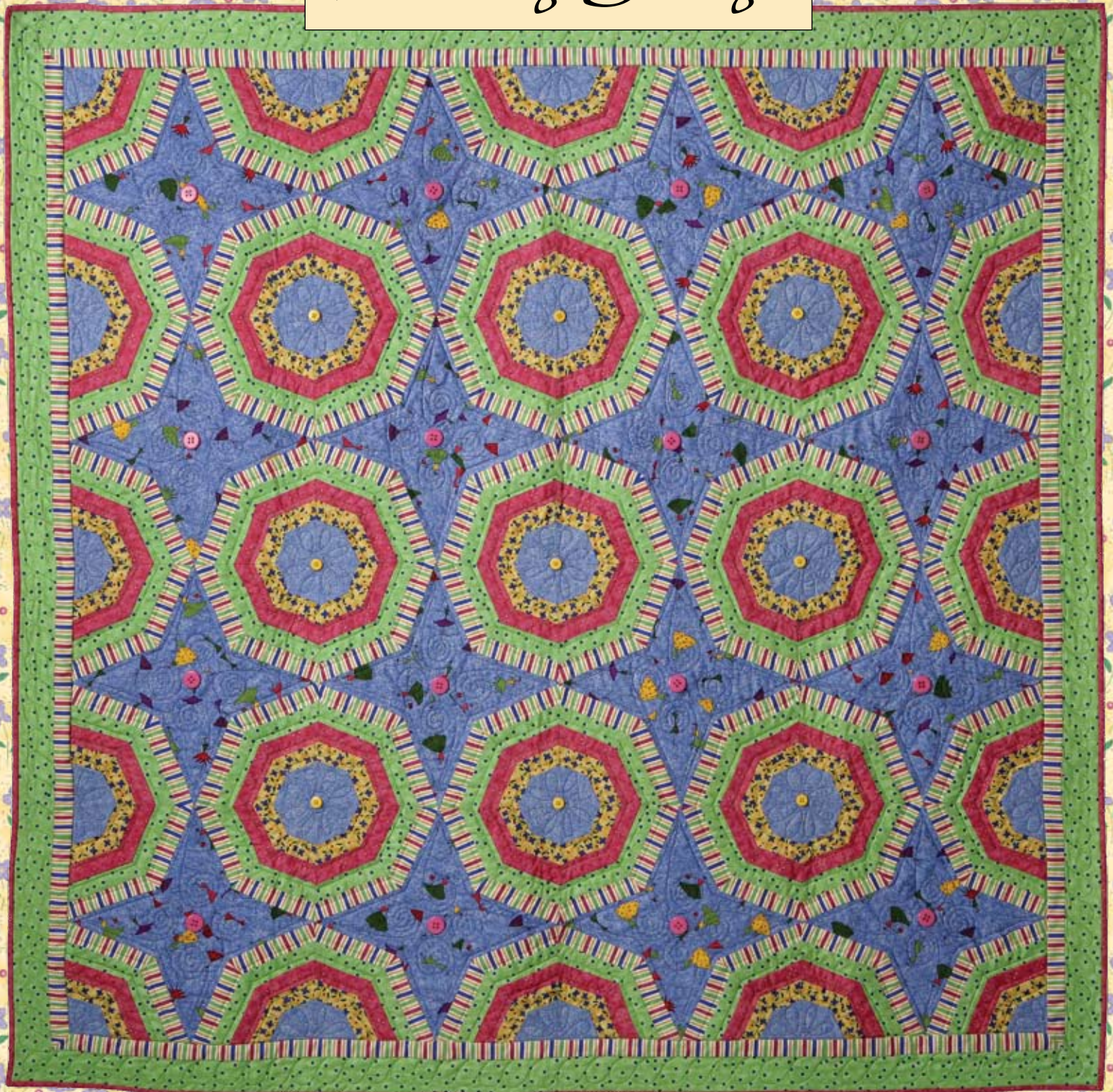


Dancing Strings



Dancing Silhouettes Fabric Line by Sue Penn for Camelot Cottons

Materials Needed:

Blue Dancing Silhouettes (DS/A #1) - 1 1/2 yards
Blue Swirl fabric (DS/G #5) - 2/3 yard
Stripe (DS/D #4) - 1 yard
Green Dots (DS/E #3) - 1 yard
Pink Tone on Tone (DS/C #4) - 1 yard

Yellow Floral (DS/B #2) - 1 yard
Stripe (DS/D #4) - 1/4 yard for 1st border
Green Dots (DS/E #3) - 3/4 yard for 2nd border
Pink Tone on Tone (DS/C #4) - 5/8 yard for binding
Green Dancing Silhouettes (DS/A #2) - 4 yards for backing

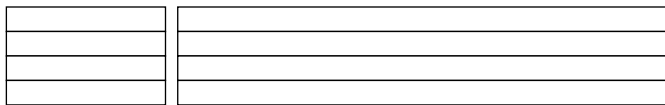

Cutting:

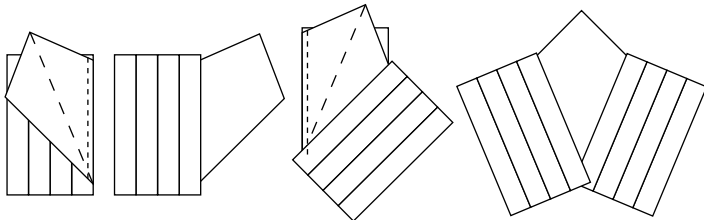
1. Trace 64 of template A to wrong side of blue Dancing Silhouettes fabric. Cut on traced lines.
2. Trace 128 of template B to wrong side of blue Swirl fabric. Cut on traced lines.
3. Cut twenty-two strips 1-1/2" by fabric width from each of the four strip fabrics.

Piecing a Block Segment

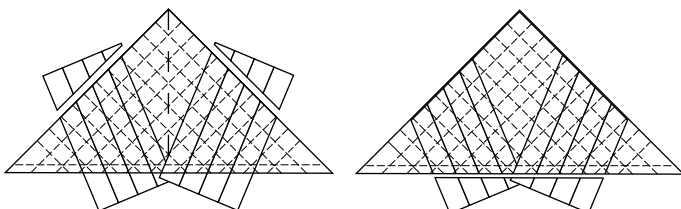
1. Stitch the four 1 1/2" strips together in this order: Stripe, Green Dots, Pink Tone on Tone and Yellow Floral. Press open. Repeat for all the strip sets. Cut into 6 1/2" segments.



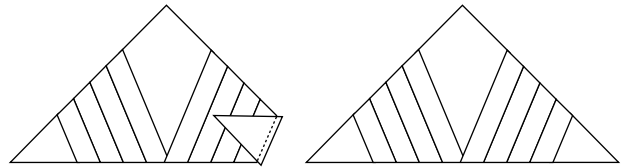
2. On the wrong side draw a line down the middle of piece A.
3. With right sides together lay fabric piece A on the strip segment with one of the long sides along the Striped fabric strip. Stitch 1/4" from the edge. Press towards the strip segment.
4. Lay the unit from above on another strip segment with the long sides along the Striped fabric strip again. Stitch 1/4" from the edge. Press towards the strip segment.



5. On the wrong side lay a 6" or 8" Omnigrad© Triangle ruler on top of the pieced segment with the 90 degree angle at the top. Make sure that the middle of the ruler lines up with the pencil line. Trim either side.
6. Slide the ruler down keeping the center lined up with the pencil line until the lower edge is 1/4" below where the seams meet. Trim bottom edge.

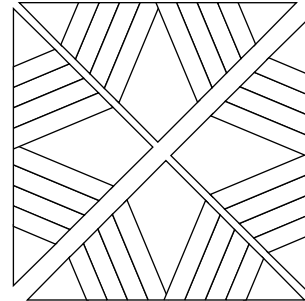


7. Stitch a fabric piece B to either side end. Press to the outside.



Piecing a Block

1. Stitch two segments together. Press open. Repeat.
2. Stitch a two-segment unit to another two-segment unit. Press open.
3. Make 16 blocks this way each with four segments.



Finishing

1. Stitch together four rows of four blocks each.
2. Measure length and width of quilt center.
3. Add 1 1/2" borders of the Stripe fabric to top and bottom and either side.
4. Add 3" borders of Green Dots fabric to top and bottom and either side.
5. Quilt as desired and bind in Pink Tone on Tone.
6. Enjoy!
