

# Leaf Candlescape

## Materials You Will Need:

- 12-1/2" square of green wool felt
- 4" square of beige wool felt
- (7) 4" squares of assorted gold and orange wool felt
- Embroidery floss in assorted colors
- (7) leaf buttons
- Aileens Tacky Glue
- Water-soluble marking pen

## MAKING THE CANDLESCAPE

*(Note: Prewash all wool by soaking like colors in hot water. Squeeze out excess water, but do not twist or wring. Dry in a hot dryer.)*

1. Lightly trace the leaf template onto the (7) 4" squares of gold and orange wool felt, and the center circle template onto the 4" square of beige wool felt. Cut on lines.
2. Position the beige circle in the middle of the 12-1/2" green wool felt square. Lightly tack in place using Aileens Tacky Glue.
3. Place the (7) leaves evenly around the center circle and lightly tack in place.
4. Stitch the center circle and the leaves to the background with (2) strands of floss and a straight stitch.

5. Trim excess background fabric, leaving about 3/8" all the way around the leaves.

6. Add the veins on the leaves with (2) strands of floss and a stem stitch.

7. Stitch the leaf buttons around the circle.
