## Heart/Star Pillow

### Materials You Will Need:

- 1/3 yard of a blue print for star pillow
- 1/4 yard of a yellow print for star pillow
- 1/3 yard of a light red print for heart pillow
- 1/4 yard of a dark red print for heart pillow
- Fusible web
- Fairfield Polyfill®

### Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

Cut out (2) star/heart shapes, using the large star/heart pattern. One will be the front of the pillow and one will be the back.

Trace one of the small star/heart patterns onto the back of the fusible web. Fuse onto the wrong side of the yellow/red print fabric. Cut out the star/heart and remove the paper backing from the fusible web. Iron onto the center of the pillow front. Stitch around the star/heart using clear thread and a zigzag stitch.

Place the large star/heart shapes right sides together and stitch around, leaving a 3" opening for turning. Clip corners and curves. Turn right side out and stuff with Polyfil®. Slip stitch the opening closed.

# Dream/Giggle Pillow

## Materials You Will Need:

### Dream Pillow

Fat quarter each of (1) red and (1) gold flannel print  
1/3 yard of a dark red flannel print  
Fat eighth of a blue flannel print  
(3) star buttons  
Blue embroidery floss  
Fusible web  
Fairfield Polyfil®

### Giggle Pillow

Fat quarter each of (1) red and (1) gold flannel print  
1/3 yard of a blue flannel print  
Fat eighth of a dark red flannel print  
(2) red buttons  
Red embroidery floss  
Fusible web  
Fairfield Polyfil®

## Cutting Directions:

### Dream Pillow

From each of the red and gold flannel prints, cut:  
(2) 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" pieces  
(2) 1-3/4" x 7" pieces  
(1) moon appliqué piece  
(1) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece  
From the dark red flannel print, cut:  
(1) 8-1/2" x 12" piece  
From the blue flannel print, cut:  
"dream" letters

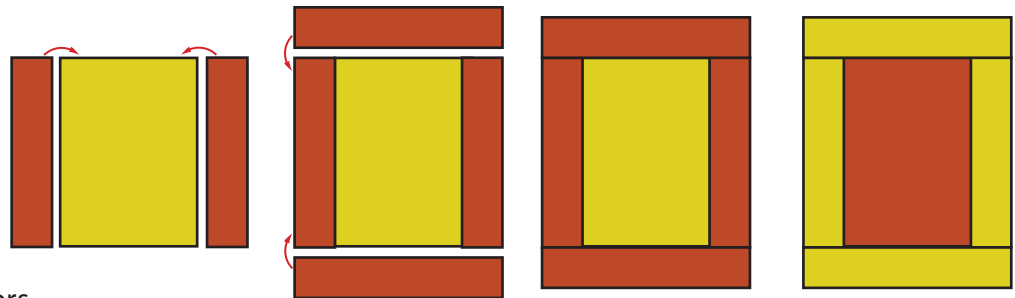
### Giggle Pillow

From the gold flannel print, cut:  
(4) 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" pieces  
(4) 1-3/4" x 7" pieces  
(2) star appliqué pieces  
From the red flannel print, cut:  
(2) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces  
From the blue flannel print, cut:  
(1) 8-1/2" x 12" piece  
From the dark red flannel print, cut:  
"giggle" letters

## Sewing Directions: (instructions written for the "Dream" pillow)

### Framed Block

Sew (1) 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" red strip to the sides of (1) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" gold piece. Press toward the red. Sew (1) 1-3/4" x 7" red strip to the top and bottom of the gold piece to complete the framed block. In the same manner, make a second block reversing the colors.



### Appliqué

Trace (2) moons onto the paper side of the fusible web, leaving at least 1/2" space between each. Cut out 1/4" beyond the drawn lines. Refer to pillow photo; following manufacturer's instructions, iron the moons to the wrong side of the appropriate fabric. Cut out each on the drawn line. Fuse to the opposite colored rectangle and stitch using a zigzag or blanket stitch.

Trace the “dream” letters on the paper side of fusible web. Iron onto the wrong side of the blue flannel fabric and cut out the letters. Remove the paper backing from the fusible web.

Place the letters onto the center of the 8 ½” x 12” dark red piece. Iron the letters in place. Stitch around each letter using clear thread and a zigzag stitch. Stitch a moon block to each side of the rectangle. Measure the length of your pillow top and cut the remaining dark red flannel to this measurement. Place the pillow front and back, right sides together and stitch around all four sides, leaving a 6 inch opening at the bottom. Clip corners. Turn right side out, pull corners out, and stuff with Polyfil®. Slip stitch the opening closed.

For the dream pillow:

After finishing the pillow, stitch 3 wooden star buttons on the pillow front. Leave the floss long enough to tie a couple of knots and then trim it so that there is about ¼” coming out of the button.

For the giggle pillow:

Stitch around the inside of each star, close to the edge, using red thread. Sew a button in the center of each star using red embroidery floss. Leave floss long enough to tie a knot. Repeat with the other two button holes. Trim, leaving about ½” of the floss coming out of the button.

## Framed Cuddle Sign

### Materials You Will Need:

1/4 to 1/3 yard of flannel print (depending on the size of your frame)  
(8 to 10) 3” to 4” scraps of assorted flannel prints  
Fusible web  
Wooden frame

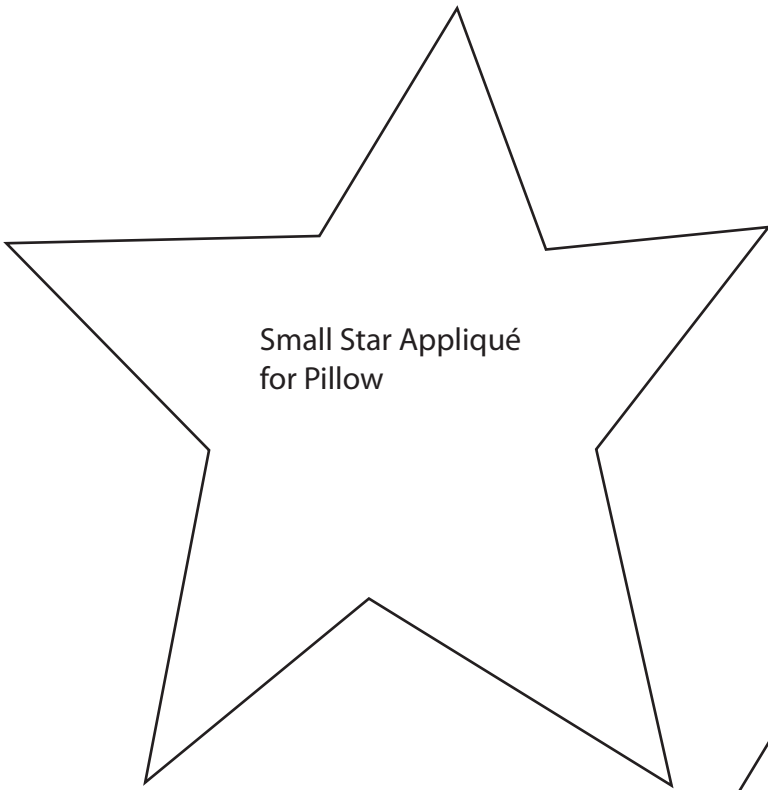
### Assembly:

Remove the back from the frame and measure the frame insert. Cut the flannel print to this size.

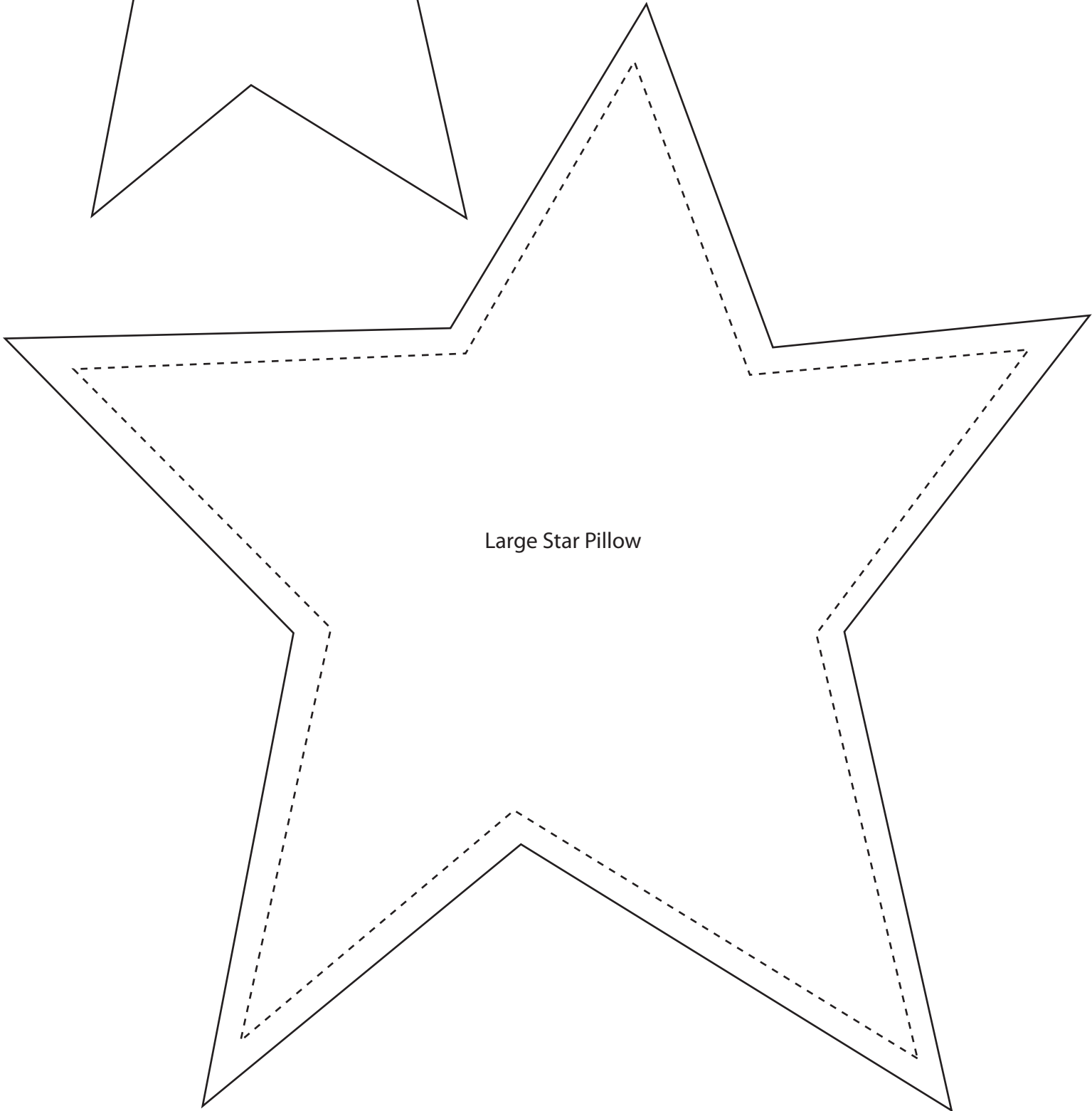
Trace the cuddle letters onto the paper side of the fusible web and iron onto the assorted scraps. If using the star shapes, trace two of the larger stars and two of the smaller ones onto the paper side of the fusible web. Iron the larger stars onto matching scraps and the smaller stars onto different matching scraps. Remove the paper backing from the fusible web.

Place the letters onto the rectangle that you’ve cut from the flannel print. Iron them on once you have them where you want them. If using the stars, iron the large stars on first, then iron the smaller stars in the centers of the larger ones. Stitch around each one using clear thread and a zigzag stitch. Press well.

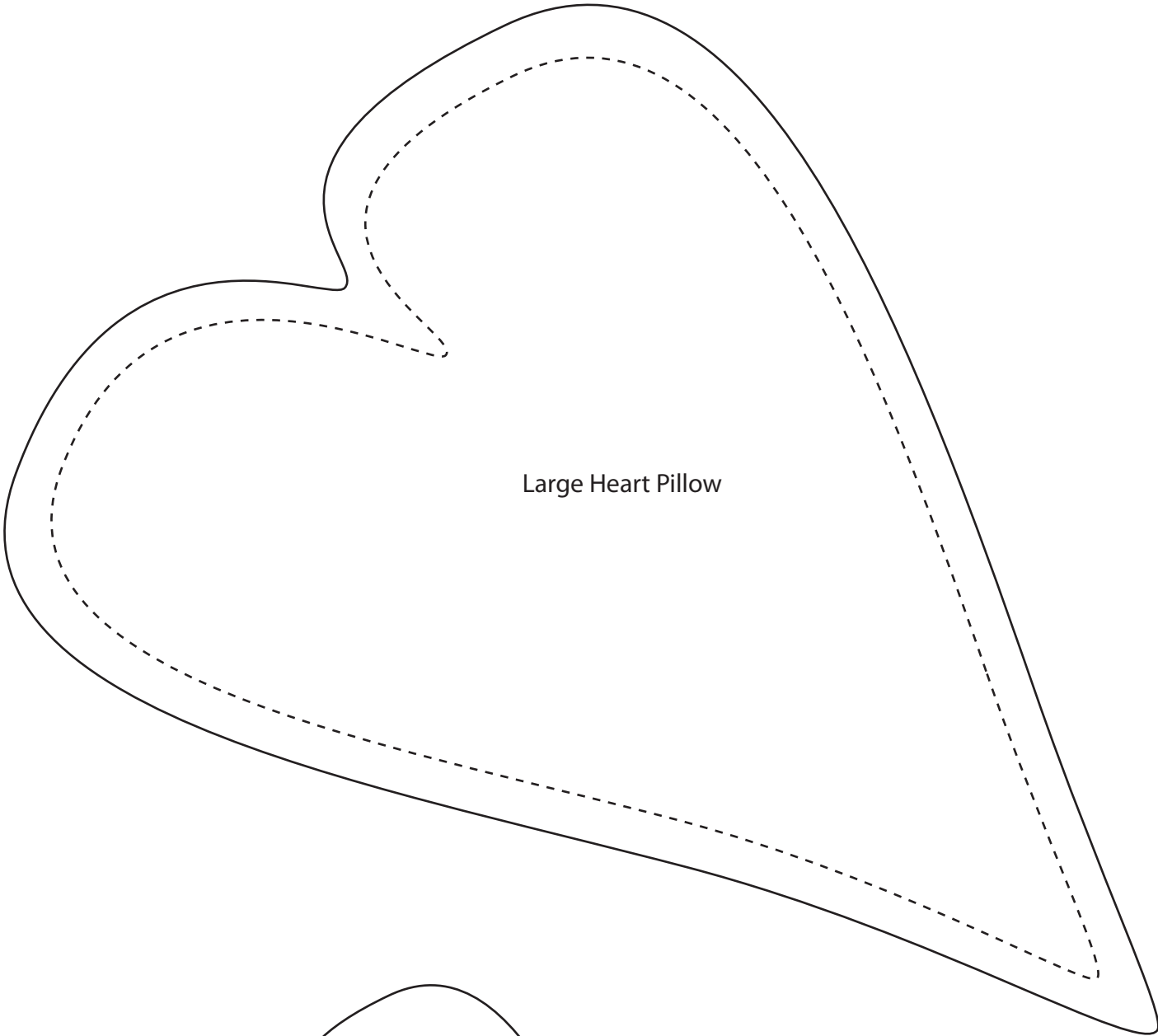
Insert into frame and replace the back.



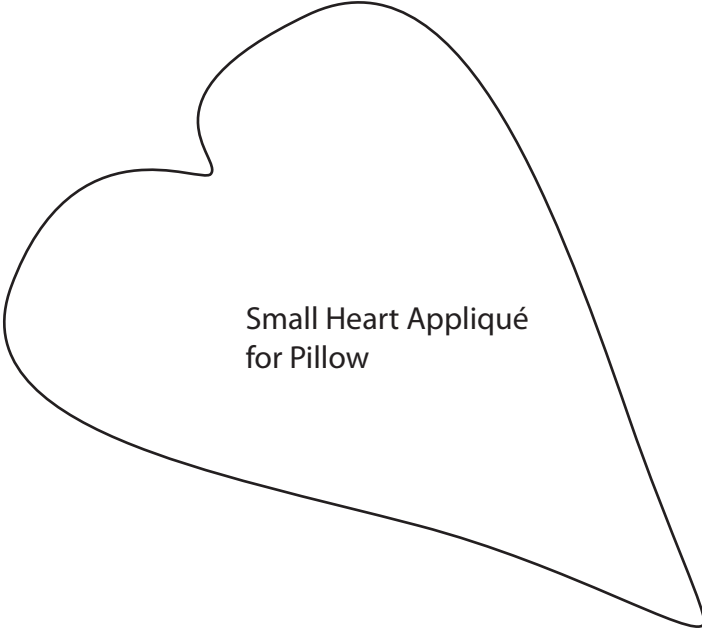
Small Star Appliqué
