

Fabric Stash Blocks

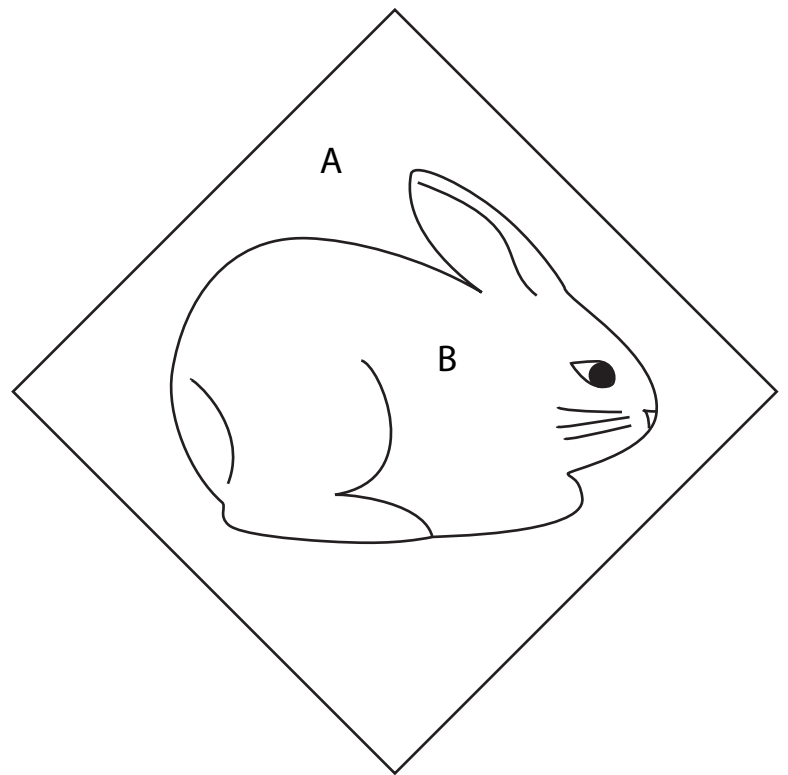

These exact fabrics may not still be available for purchase. Take heart! Your favorite quilt shop can help you select suitable substitutes in colors and patterns that will work just as well to make this block.



12" Chocolate Bunny

What Easter celebration would be complete without a chocolate bunny? This one is low-fat, however, pretty in a brown floral print and diagonally appliquéd on a whimsical stripe. Set your sewing machine on a tight zigzag stitch to highlight the bunny's sweet features.

Fabric: 20566-PA (Pink/Chocolate); 25486-A (Chocolate)

A - Cut (1) 12-1/2" square of pink/chocolate stripe

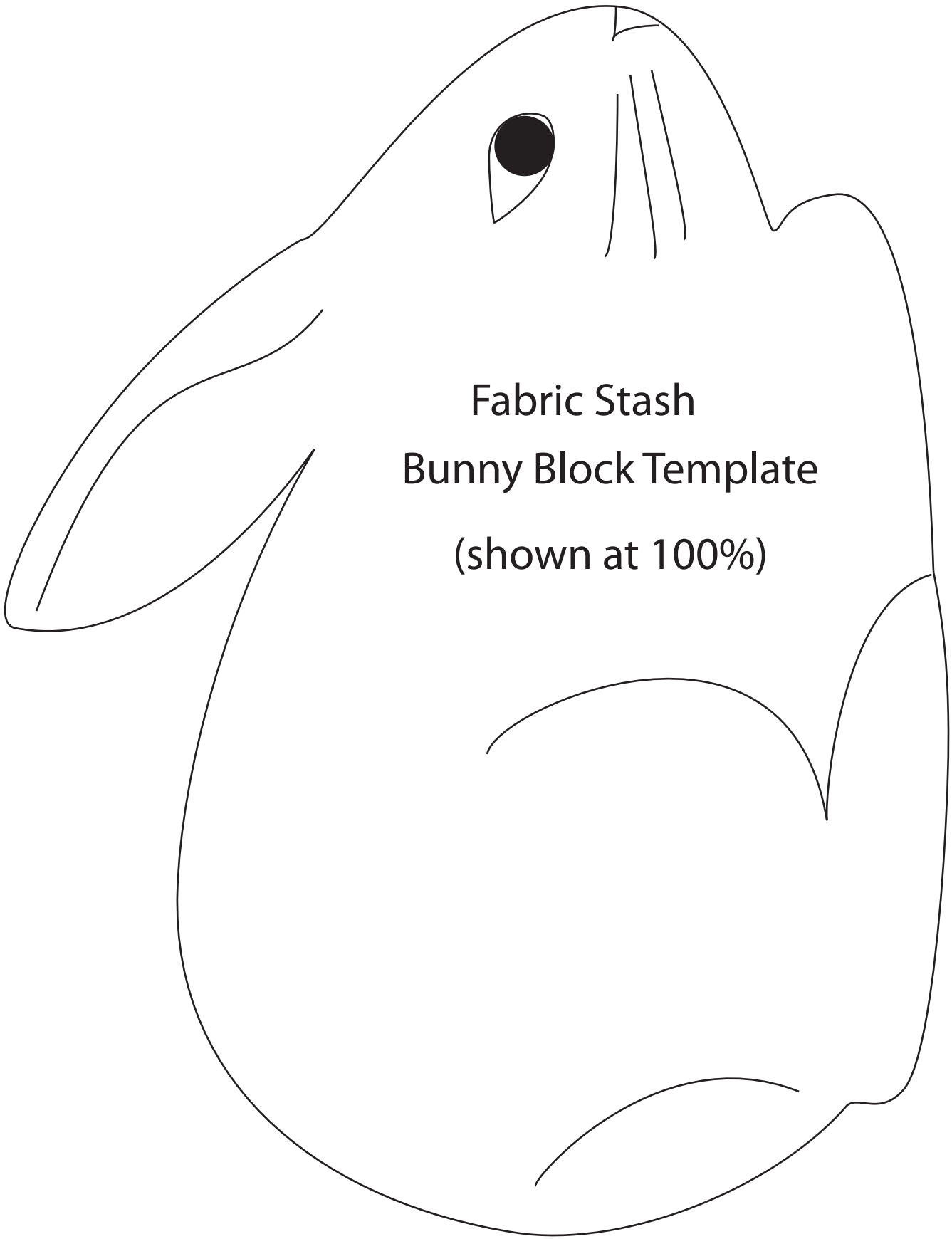
B - Cut (1) 13" square of chocolate floral

ASSEMBLING THE BLOCK:

(Note: Template and instructions are given using the fusible appliqué method. For needle-turn method be sure and add a 1/4" seam allowance to template.)

Trace the Bunny Block Template onto the paper side of fusible web. Cut out the bunny, 1/4" beyond the drawn outline. Following manufacturer's instructions, iron the bunny to the wrong side of the chocolate floral square. Cut out the bunny on the drawn outline.

Refer to block picture above; fuse the bunny to the diagonal 12-1/2" square of pink/chocolate stripe. Appliqué using a blanket or satin stitch. Stitch the bunny detail lines using embroidery stitches to complete the Chocolate Bunny block.
