Materials You Will Need: (Makes 2 shams)

- (1) Fat quarter of a large cream floral
- (1) Fat quarter of a cream mottled
- 1/2 yard of a dark purple mottled
- 2-1/2 yards of a dark green small print,
includes backing

Cutting Directions:

From the large cream floral, cut:

- (4) 8" squares

From the cream mottled, cut:

- (4) 2-3/4" x 21-1/2" strips

From the dark purple mottled, cut:

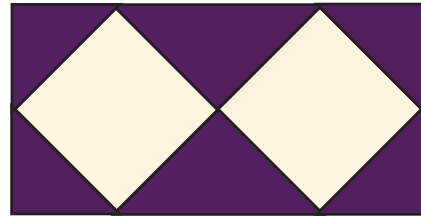
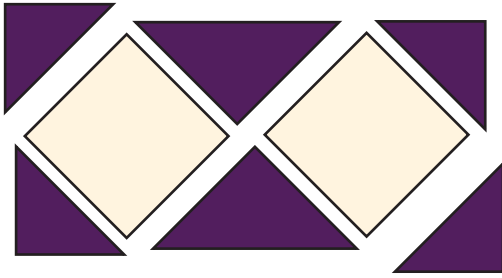
- (1) 12" square, then cut in half diagonally twice to make (4) setting triangles
- (4) 6-1/4" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (8) corner triangles

From the dark green small print, cut:

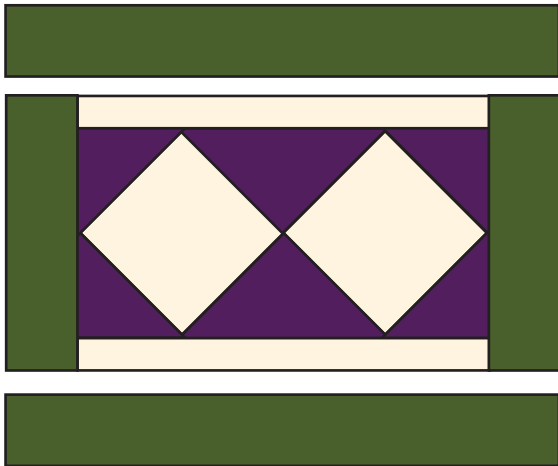
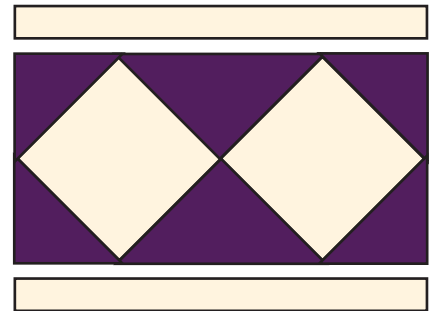
- (4) 5-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips
- (4) 5-1/2" x 31-1/2" strips
- (4) 19" x 25-1/2" pieces

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

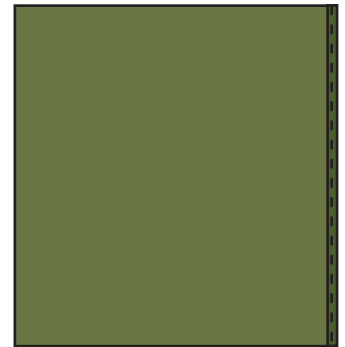
1. Lay out (2) 8" large cream floral squares, (2) dark purple setting triangles, and (4) dark purple corner triangles in diagonal rows, as shown. Sew the units together in each row. Join the rows to make the sham front.



2. Sew a 2-3/4" x 21-1/2" cream mottled strip to the top and bottom of the sham front.



3. Sew a 5-1/2" x 15-1/2" dark green strip to the sides of the sham front. Sew a 5-1/2" x 25-1/2" dark green strip to the top and bottom of the sham front.



4. To make the back, hem (2) 19" x 25-1/2" dark green pieces by folding one 25-1/2" side 1/4" toward the wrong side of the fabric. Press. Fold again, 1/4" and topstitch to hem.

5. Lay the sham front, right side up, on a flat surface. Lay one of the backs on top of the sham front, right sides together, and pin, matching the raw edges on the top, bottom, and sides. Repeat with the other back, pinning on the top, bottom, and sides. The two back pieces will overlap in the center. Stitch around all four sides. Clip corners and turn right side out.
