Materials You Will Need:

- (1) tiger motif print
- 7/8 yard of a brown swirl print
- (1) Fat quarter of a blue spruce print

Cutting Directions:

From the tiger motif print, cut:

- (1) 8-1/2" square, fussy cut to center tiger motif

From the brown swirl print, cut:

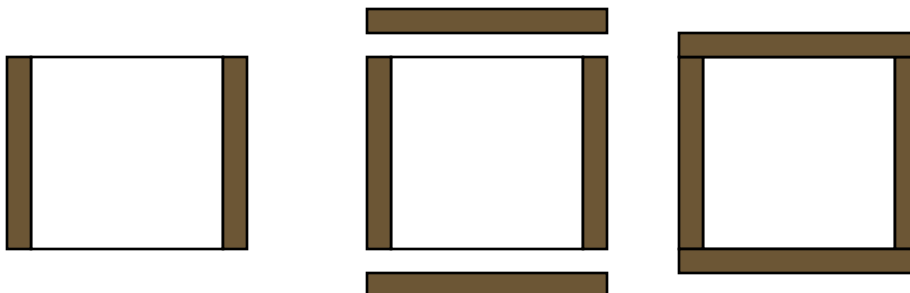
- (2) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces
- (2) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces
- (2) 2" x 15" pieces
- (2) 2" x 18-1/2" pieces
- (1) 18-1/2" square for backing

From the blue spruce print, cut:

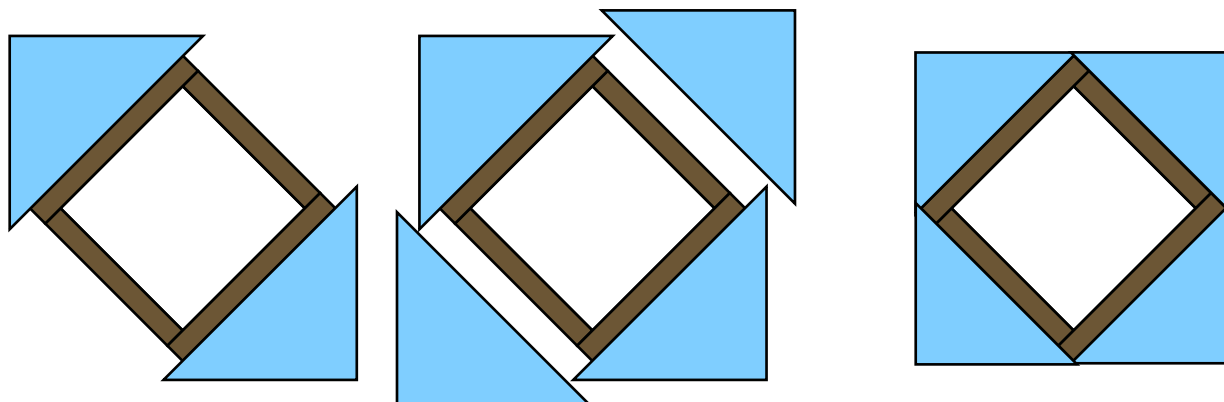
- (2) 8-1/2" squares, then cut in half diagonally once
to make (4) corner triangles

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

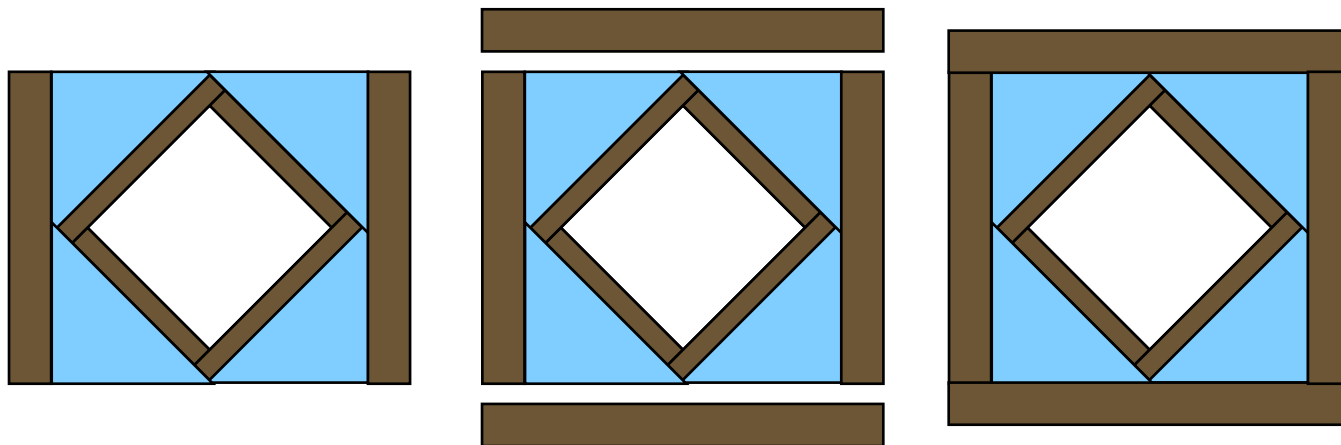
1. Sew (2) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" brown swirl pieces to the sides of the 8-1/2" tiger square. Sew a 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" brown swirl piece to the top and bottom of the tiger square.



2. Center and sew (2) blue spruce corner triangles to opposite sides of the tiger square, noting the direction of the spruce print. In the same manner, sew (2) corner triangles to the remaining sides of the tiger square. Trim to measure 15" square.



3. Sew (2) 2" x 15" brown swirl pieces to the sides of the tiger square. Sew a 2" x 18-1/2" brown swirl piece to the top and bottom of the tiger square.



4. Place the 18-1/2" brown swirl square, right sides together, on the pillow front. Sew around all four sides leaving a 5" opening for turning. Turn right side out and press. Stuff firmly with polyfil and hand stitch the opening closed.
