Materials You Will Need:

1-5/8 yards of a plum floral print
1-5/8 yards of a red and green floral print
1-5/8 yards of a plum plaid
1-3/8 yards of a floral print
5/8 yard of a burgundy tonal, includes binding
1/2 yard of an amethyst tonal
3-1/2 yards of backing fabric
61" x 76" piece of batting

Cutting Directions:

From the plum floral print:

(3) 7-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips, cut lengthwise

From the red and green floral print:

(2) 5-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips, cut lengthwise

From the plum plaid:

(4) 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips, cut lengthwise

From the floral print:

(6) 7-1/2" x 42" strips

From the burgundy tonal:

(7) 2-1/4" x 42" strips for the binding

From the amethyst tonal:

(5) 2-1/2" x 42" strips

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Sew a 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" plum plaid strip to each long side of a 5-1/2" x 54-1/2" red and green floral strip. (Make 2)

2. Refer to quilt photo; sew the (2) pieced strips from step #1, alternating with (3) 7-1/2" x 54-1/2" plum floral strips to make the quilt top.

3. Sew the short ends of the (5) 2-1/2" x 42" amethyst tonal strips together to make a long strip. Crosscut this strip into (2) 54-1/2" strips and (2) 43-1/2" strips. Sew the 54-1/2" strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the 43-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

4. Sew the short ends of the (3) 7-1/2" x 42" floral strips together to make a long strip. Crosscut this strip into (2) 58-1/2" strips and (2) 57-1/2" strips. Sew the 58-1/2" strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the 57-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

5. Quilt as desired. Bind using the 2-1/4" x 42" burgundy tonal strips to finish the quilt.
