

Zig Zag Pillow Shams and Pillows

Web bonus projects for *Pop-Up Retro Daisies*,
featured in *Quick Quilts #100 Spring 2009*



Web Bonus pattern for quilt

Pillow Shams

Materials You Will Need:

1-3/8 yards of a large zig zag print
1-3/8 yards of a yellow print
1/2 yard of a green/brown bead print

Cutting Directions:

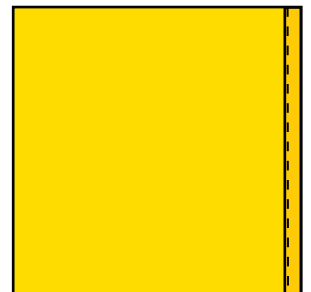
From the large zig zag, cut:
(2) 20-1/2" x 28-1/2" pieces

From the yellow print, cut:
(4) 20-1/2" squares

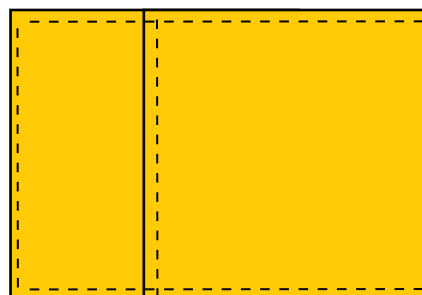
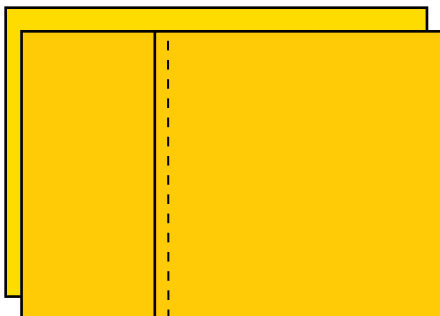
From the green/brown bead print, cut:
(6) 2-1/4" x 42" strips

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Hem (1) side of each of the 20-1/2" yellow print squares by folding over 1", pressing, and then folding over 1" and stitching.



2. Lay a 20-1/2" x 28-1/2" zig zag print piece right side down and position (2) 20-1/2" yellow print squares on top, right sides up, with the hems in the center and matching raw edges. Pin and baste.



3. Sew (3) 2-1/4" x 42" green/brown print strips short ends together to create a binding strip. Fold in half lengthwise, right sides together, and press. Pin to the outside edge of the pillow shams, matching raw edges, and stitch. Turn the folded binding edge to the back of the pillow sham and blindstitch in place.

4. Repeat to make a second pillow sham.

Pillows

(1) 12" pillow and (2) 9" pillows

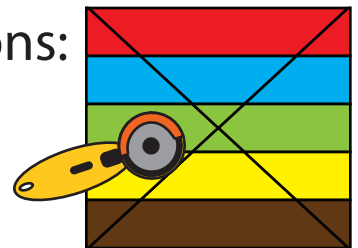
Materials You Will Need:

4 leftover rail blocks from the quilt top
3/8 yard of a yellow print
Fairfield Poly-fil®

Cutting Directions:

Cut each rail block in half diagonally twice

From the yellow print, cut:
(2) 9-1/2" squares
(1) 12-1/2" square



Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Referring to the pillow photo, lay out the rail pieces as shown. Use (8) section for the 12" square pillow and (4) sections each for the 9" square pillows.

2. Pin the sections together and stitch. Square the pillows up so they measure 12-1/2" square and 9-1/2" square, respectively.

3. Layer each pillow top right sides together with a corresponding size yellow print square. Stitch around all sides, leaving an opening for turning. Clip corner and turn right side out. Stuff with poly-fil and blind stitch opening shut.
