Doll Quilt

Materials You Will Need:

- 1/8 yard each of a pink, green, turquoise,
and lavender print
- 1/4 yard of a stripe, includes binding
- 1/4 yard of a patchwork print
- 3/4 yard of backing fabric
- 27" x 32" piece of batting

Cutting Directions:

From each of the pink, green, turquoise, and
lavender prints, cut:

- (2) 2" x 14" strips

From the stripe, cut:

- (9) 3/4" x 14" strips
- (2) 3/4" x ?? " strips
- (3) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, for binding

From the patchwork print, cut:

- (4) 3" x 21" strips

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

MAKING THE QUILT

Referring to the quilt photo, sew the (8) 2" x 14" print strips together lengthwise, alternating with the (9) 3/4" x 14" stripe strips.

ASSEMBLY

1. Sew $3/4$ " x $14-3/4$ " stripe strips to the sides of the quilt.
2. Sew 3" x 21" patchwork print strips to the sides of the quilt. Press and trim excess. Sew the remaining patchwork print strips to the top and bottom. Press and trim excess.

FINISHING

Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting and quilt as desired. Use the (3) $2-1/4$ " x 42" stripe strips to bind the quilt.

Pillow

Materials You Will Need:

$1/2$ yard of a stripe
12-15 miniature buttons
 $1/2$ yard length of flower trim
14" square pillow form

Cutting Directions:

From the stripe, cut:

- (1) $12-1/2$ " square
- (2) $1-1/2$ " x $12-1/2$ " strips
- (2) $1-1/2$ " x $14-1/2$ " strips
- (2) $14-1/2$ " x 10" pieces

MAKING THE PILLOW

1. Cut the flower motifs from the trim. Lay them out on the $12-1/2$ " stripe square in a pleasing pattern. Place a miniature button on top each flower and hand sew the flower and button in place.
2. Sew the $1-1/2$ " x $12-1/2$ " stripe strips to opposite sides of the $12-1/2$ " stripe square. Sew the $1-1/2$ " x $14-1/2$ " stripe strips to the top and bottom to create a $14-1/2$ " pillow front.
3. Hem each 10" x $14-1/2$ " stripe piece along one long edge. Lay the pillow front right side up and the two hemmed pieces right sides down, matching raw edges and positioning the hemmed edges in the middle. Pin and stitch around the outside edge using a $1/4$ " seam allowance. Turn and fill with a 14" square pillow form.
