When opened, each image file should appear in the proper orientation. Please label each image with artist's last name and image number matching the Entry Form. Discs will not be returned unless otherwise noted.

Shipments of accepted quilts must be received at Lincoln Center between these dates.

Reception: 5:00 p.m.— 7:00 p.m.

August 31, 2009

Pick-up of hand delivered quilts at the Lincoln Center between 1 p.m. and 4 p.m.

Sept. 1-4, 2009

Work will be shipped back to artists.

## ENTRY RULES

- Artist may enter up to two pieces of their original design completed within the past two years.
- Each quilt must have a four-inch (10 cm) finished; double casing (sleeve) sewn in full width of top edge of the quilt.
- Lincoln Center reserves the right to accept or reject submitted quilts.

## SHIPPING

- Place each quilt in a separate cloth or bag marked with your name, address, phone number and quilt title.
- Each quilt must be clearly labeled on the back, with name of the quilt, name of the quilt-maker/s, address and phone number.
- Place the cloth bag within a plastic bag for additional protection.

- All shipping costs are the responsibility of the entrant. Please provide us with prepaid return mailing label for U.P.S. or FedEx.

- Seal your quilt into a sturdy container. The same container will be used to return your quilt to you.
