

# Folk Art Table Runner

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(15-1/2" x 51-1/2")

Skill Level: Easy

Technique: Patchwork

Block Count and Size: (5) 9" square Star blocks

*Fun prints in flannels create a warm and friendly  
welcome to friends gathering for an afternoon lunch.*

## Materials You Will Need:

3/4 yard of a cream stripe  
5/8 yard of a green plaid, includes binding  
1/2 yard of a red with black dot  
3/8 yard of a black basket weave  
1-5/8 yards of backing  
20" x 56" piece of batting

## Cutting Directions:

From the cream stripe, cut:

(4) 2-1/2" squares  
(12) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces  
(24) 3-1/4" squares  
(5) 3-1/2" squares  
(8) 1-1/2" x 2-3/4" pieces  
(8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces  
(4) 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces

From the green plaid, cut:

(40) 2-1/2" squares  
(4) 2-1/4" x 42" strips for binding

From the red with black dot, fussy cut each piece

to center widthwise and lengthwise the black dots:

(10) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces  
(10) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces  
(3) 1-1/2" x 42" strips

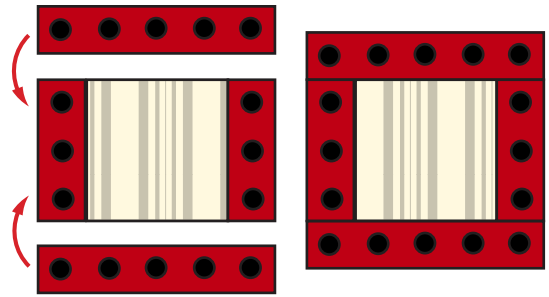
From the black basket weave, cut:

(24) 3-1/4" squares  
(4) 2-3/4" squares

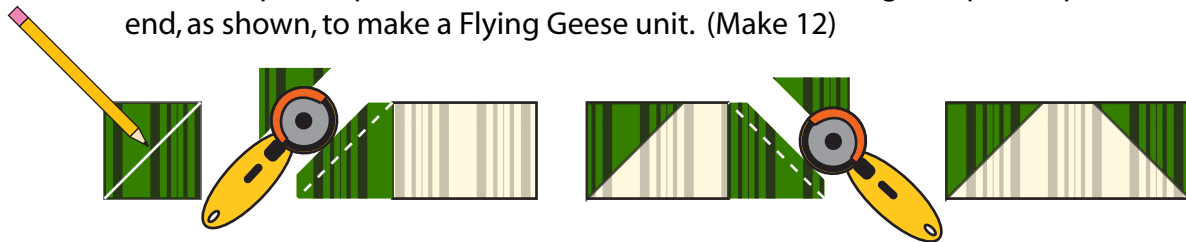
# Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

## 1. Making the Star Panel Units

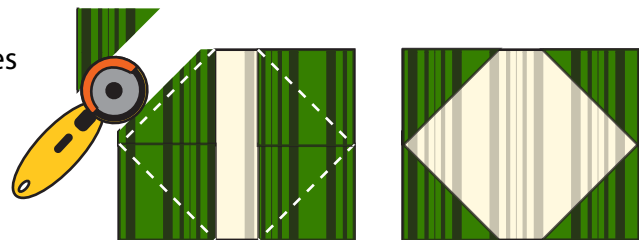
Sew a 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" red with black dot piece to opposite sides of (1) 3-1/2" cream stripe square. Sew a 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" red with black dot piece to the remaining sides of the cream square. (Make 5)



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (24) 2-1/2" green plaid squares. Place a marked square, right sides together, on the end (1) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" cream stripe piece. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the drawn line and press open. In the same manner, add a second green plaid square to the opposite end, as shown, to make a Flying Geese unit. (Make 12)

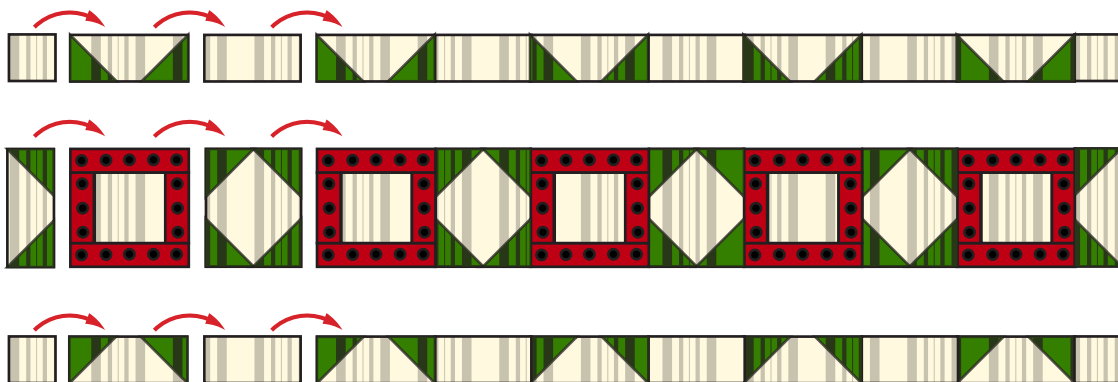


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (16) 2-1/2" green plaid squares. Place a marked square, right sides together, on one corner of (1) 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" cream stripe piece. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the drawn line and press open. In the same manner, add a green plaid square to the remaining corners, as shown, to make a diamond unit. (Make 4)



## 2. Assembling the Star Panel

Using (4) 2-1/2" cream stripe squares, (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" cream stripe pieces, and the star panel units; lay out the panel in (3) rows, as shown. Sew the units together in each row. Join the rows.



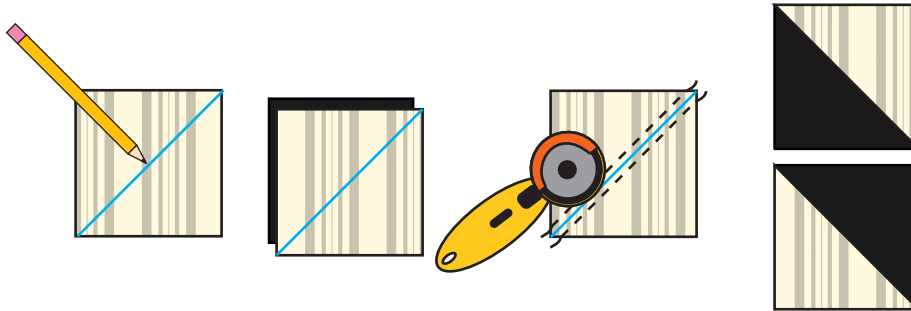
## 3. Borders

### First Border

Sew the short ends of the (3) 1-1/2" x 42" red with black dot strips together to make a long strip. Crosscut this strip into (2) 9-1/2" strips and (2) 47-1/2" strips. Sew the 9-1/2" strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the 47-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

## Second Border (pieced)

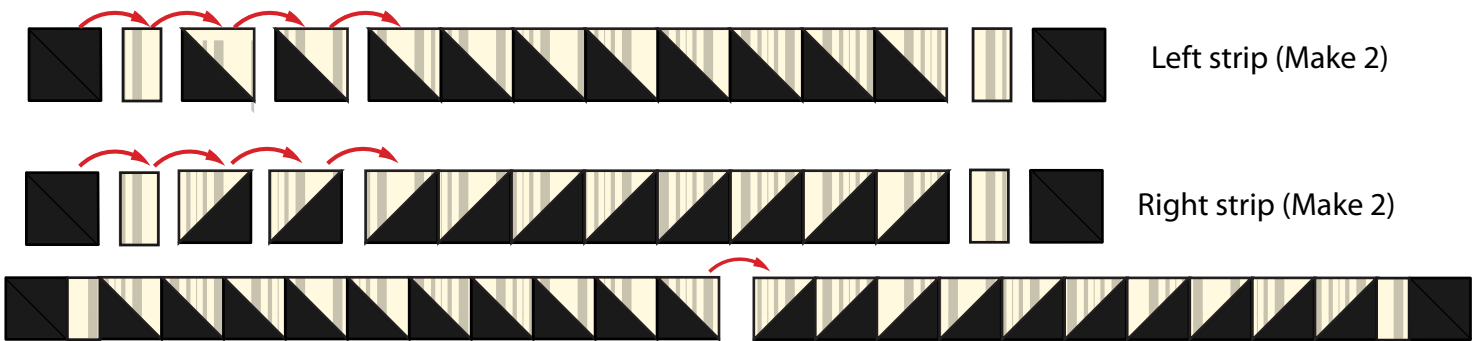
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (24) 3-1/4" cream stripe squares. Place a marked square, right sides together, on top of a 3-1/4" black basket weave square. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to make (2) half-square triangles. (Make 48 half-square triangle units.)



Stitch (10) half-square triangle units together, noting the orientation of each unit, to make a left strip. (Make 2)

Stitch (10) half-square triangle units together in the opposite direction to make a right strip. (Make 2)

Sew (1) left strip to (1) right strip, as shown, to make a border strip. Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-3/4" cream stripe piece and a 2-3/4" black basketweave square to both ends of the border strip. (Make 2 border strips.)

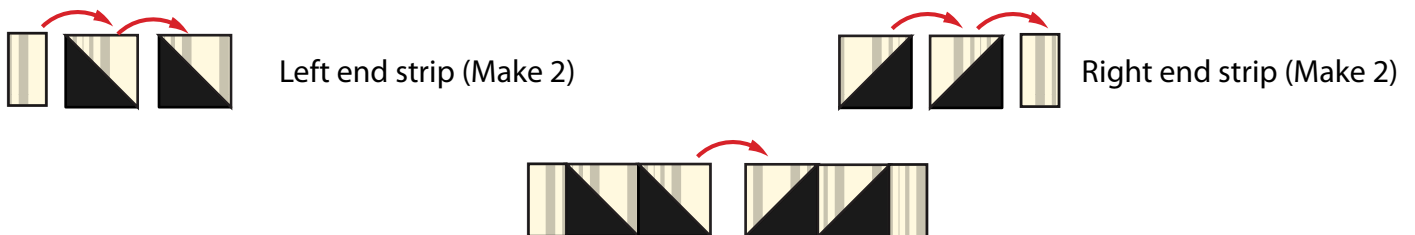


Stitch (2) half-square triangle units together, noting the orientation of each unit, to make a left end strip. (Make 2)

Stitch (2) half-square triangle units together in the opposite direction to make a right end strip. (Make 2)

Sew (1) left end strip to (1) right end strip, as shown, to make an end border strip. Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-3/4" cream stripe piece to both ends of the end border strip. (Make 2)

Sew the short borders to the sides and then the long borders to the top and bottom of the table runner.



## 5. Finishing

Quilt as desired. Finish using the (4) 2-1/4" x 42" green plaid strips to bind the quilt.
