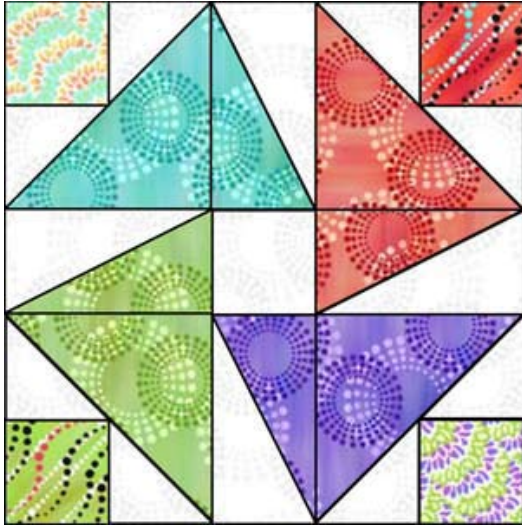


# Fabric Stash Blocks

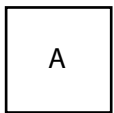
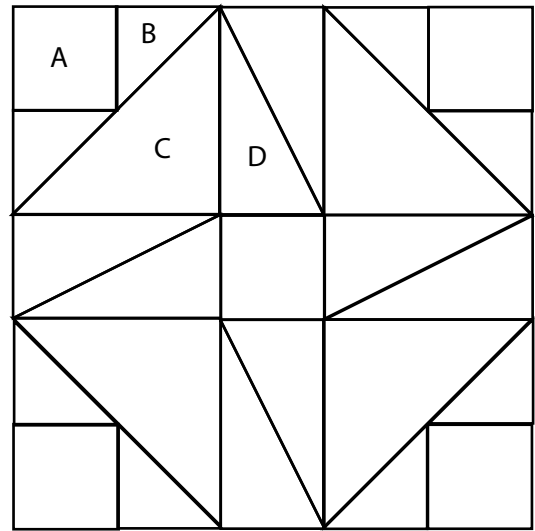

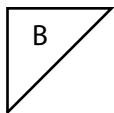


## 15" Follow the Leader

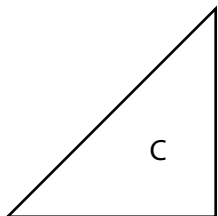
A copycat game children play by imitating their leader's movements. These wedges, as shown in the Proud collection by In the Beginning Fabrics, rotate as if to follow the one before. [www.inthebeginningfabrics.com](http://www.inthebeginningfabrics.com)



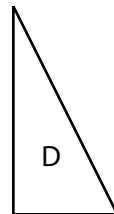
A - Cut (1) 3-1/2" square each of white, coral stripe, mint floral, purple floral, and green stripe



B - Cut (4) 3-7/8" white squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (8) small triangles



C - Cut (1) Template A triangle each of mint circles, coral circles, purple circles, and green circles



D - Cut (4) Template B triangles of white

D - Cut (1) Template B triangle each of mint circles, coral circles, purple circles, and green circles

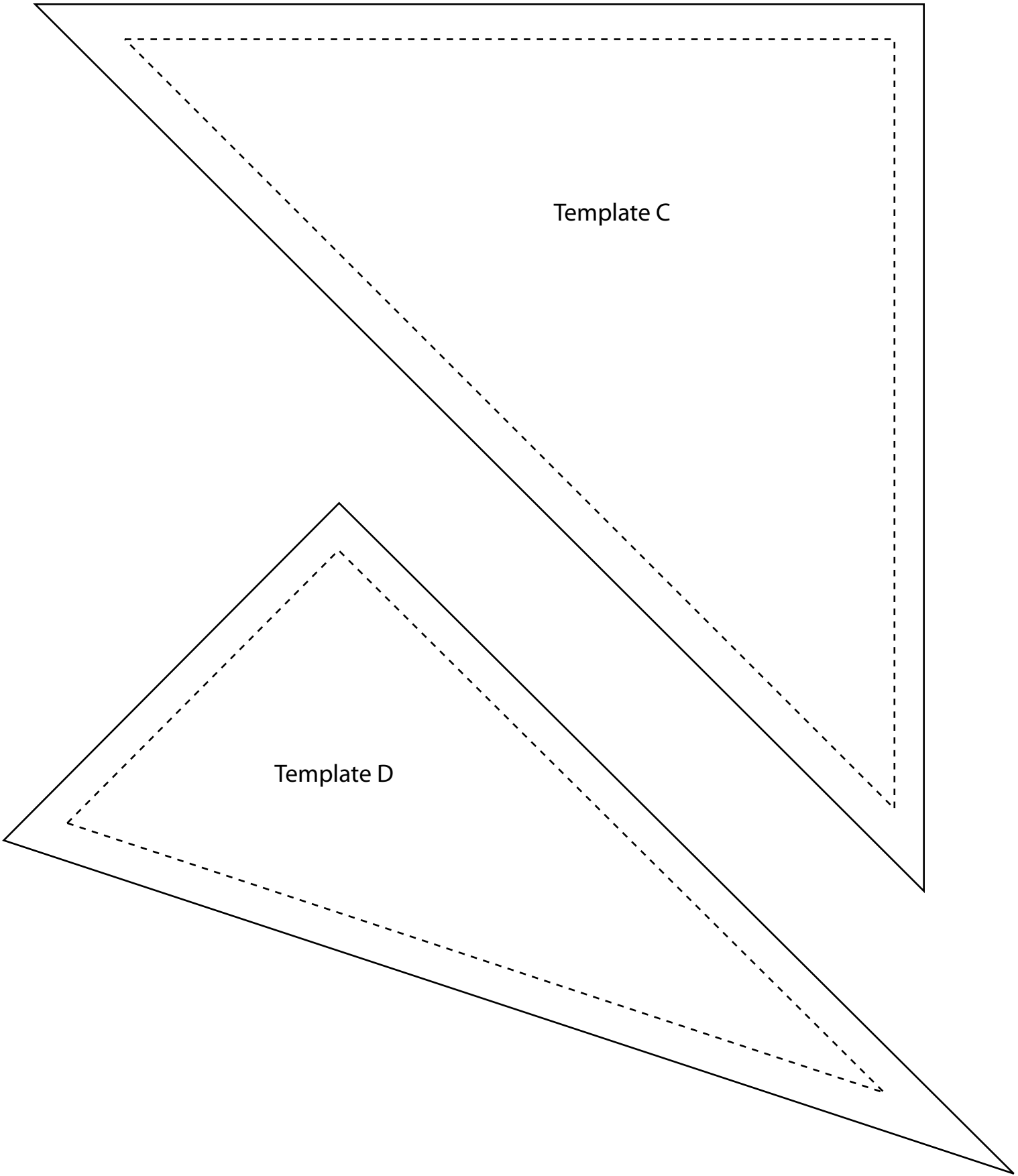
### ASSEMBLING THE BLOCK:

Refer to block picture above; sew a white Template B triangle to each of the mint, coral, purple, and green circle Template B triangles to make a pieced rectangle.

Sew a white small triangle to adjacent sides of each of the coral stripe, green stripe, mint floral, and purple floral squares to make a large pieced triangle.

Stitch a Template A triangle to its color coordinating large pieced triangle to make a 6-1/2" unfinished pieced corner square.

Lay out the block units in (3) rows of (3) units each, as shown. Sew the units together in each row. Join the rows to make a 15-1/2" unfinished Follow the Leader block.
