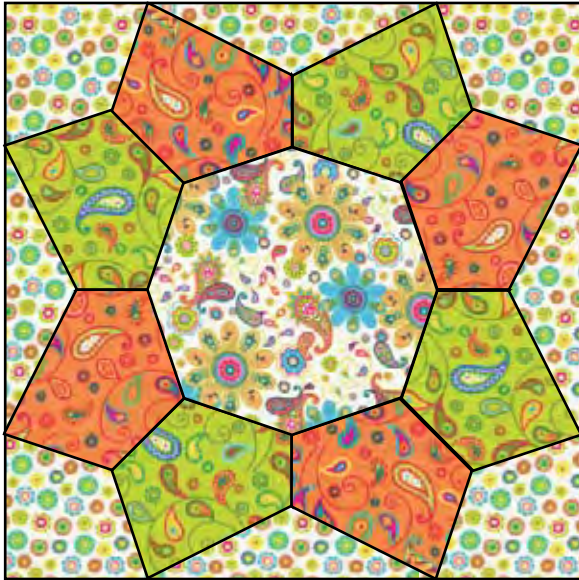


Fabric Stash Blocks

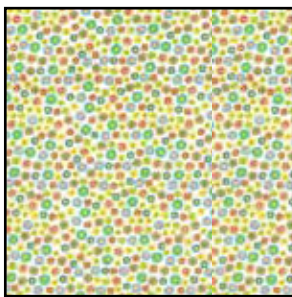

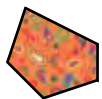
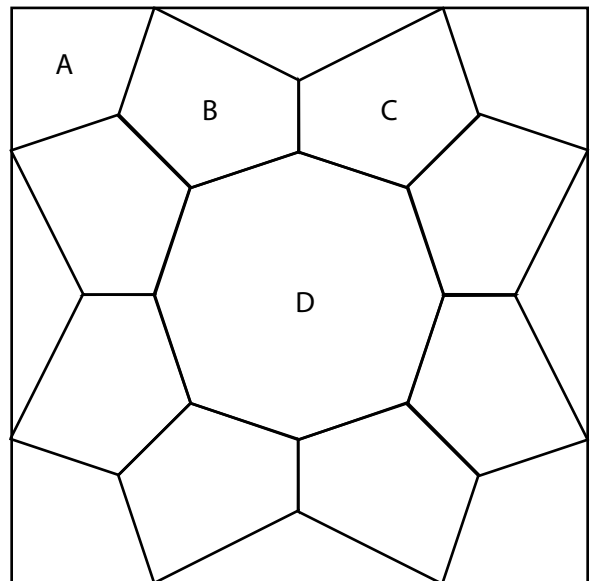


12" Ring Around the Rosy

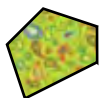
A circle game for children that involves joining hands and singing a simple rhyme. This ring of paisleys sings around a pick of posies as seen in this Chloe collection by P&B Textiles, www.pbtex.com



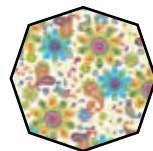
A - Cut (1) 12-1/2" square



B - Cut (4) of Template B



C - Cut (4) of Template Br



D - Cut (1) of Template A

ASSEMBLING THE BLOCK:

Refer to block picture above; sew (1) orange Template B piece to (1) green Template Br piece along the short side, as shown, to make a quarter circle unit. (Make 4)

Sew (2) quarter circle units, as shown, to make a half circle unit. (Make 2) Sew the half-circle units together to make a full circle.

Turn under 1/4" on the edges and appliqué the circle unit to the center of the 12-1/2" polka dot square on all sides. (Note: Be sure there is a 1/4" seam allowance left on the 12-1/2" polka dot square beyond the points of the full circle.)

Turn under 1/4" on the edges and appliqué the Template A floral circle to the center of the orange and green circle to make a 12-1/2" unfinished Ring Around the Rosy block.
