

Rustic Flannel Neck Roll

Materials You Will Need:

Fat eighths each of (4) light and (4) dark coordinating prints
5" x 14" Fairfield Batting neck roll pillow
1 yard of ribbon to tie the ends

Cutting Directions:

From the Fat eighths, cut a total of:
(22) 2-1/2" x 19" strips
From the ribbon, cut:
(2) 18" pieces

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Sew the long side of each of the 2-1/2" x 19" strips together to make a large panel.



2. Turn under 1/4" twice to make a double hem along the sides and press. Topstitch hem. Fold the panel in half, lengthwise, with right sides together. Sew ends together to make a tube. Turn the tube right side out and insert neck roll pillow form.

3. Tie each end with a ribbon.
