Materials You Will Need:

- Fat quarter of a floral stripe
- 1/8 yard of a purple swirl
- 3/4 yard of a yellow swirl
- (1) 16" square Home Elegance pillow form

Cutting Directions:

From the floral stripe, cut:

- (1) 8" x 9-1/2" piece, fussy cut to center
- (3) stripes

From the purple swirl, cut:

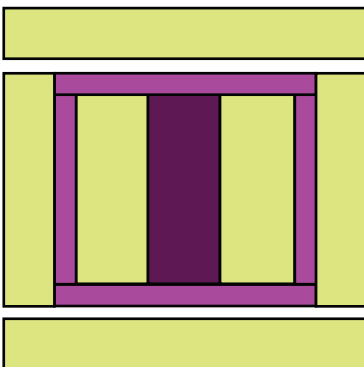
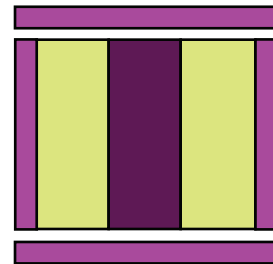
- (2) 1-1/2" x 8" strips
- (2) 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips

From the yellow swirl, cut:

- (2) 2-3/4" x 10" strips
- (2) 3-1/2" x 16" strips
- (1) 16" square

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Sew a 1-1/2" x 8" purple swirl piece to both sides of the 8" x 9-1/2" floral stripe piece. Sew a 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" purple swirl piece to the top and bottom of the floral stripe piece.



2. Sew a 2-3/4" x 10" yellow swirl piece to both sides of the floral stripe unit. Sew a 3-1/2" x 16" yellow swirl piece to the top and bottom of the floral stripe unit.

3. Stitch the 16" square yellow swirl pillow back, right sides together, to the front. Sew around the pillow using a 1/2" seam allowance, leaving an opening on the bottom edge for turning. Turn and press well. Insert the pillow form.
