Hankie Panel Wall Hanging

Quilt Size: 42" square

Materials You Will Need:

1 yard pre-printed panel yardage
3/8 yard of a light pink
3/8 yard of a dark pink
1/2 yard of a blue dot
2/3 yard of a red/white print
1/2 yard of a red bud print
2 yards of backing fabric
48" x 48" piece of 60/40 Machine Blend Batting by Fairfield Processing Corp.

Cutting Directions:

From the pre-printed panel, cut:
(1) 24-1/2" x 24-1/2" square with (9) pre-printed
square motifs centered in the cut square

From the light pink, cut:
(2) 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips
(2) 1-1/2" x 27-1/2" strips

From the dark pink, cut:
(2) 1-1/2" x 42" strips
(40) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

From the blue dot, cut:
(2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips
(40) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

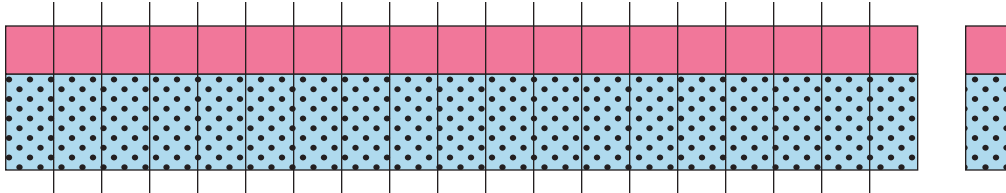
From the red/white print, cut:
(2) 4-3/4" x 33-1/2" strips
(2) 4-3/4" x 42" strips

From the red bud print, cut:
(5) 2-1/4" strips for binding

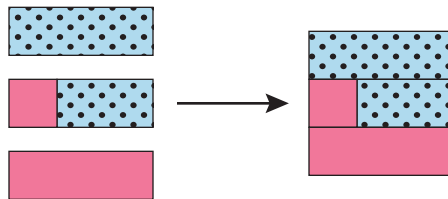
Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

Making the Wall Hanging:

1. Sew a 2" x 24-1/2" light pink strip to opposite sides of the panel square. Sew a 2" x 27-1/2" light pink strip to the top and bottom of the panel square.
2. Sew a 1-1/2" dark pink strip to a 2-1/2" blue dot strip. Repeat. Cut (20) 1-1/2" wide segments from each strip set.



3. Sew together as shown: a 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" dark pink piece, a strip set segment, and a 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" blue dot piece. Repeat to make (40) rail blocks.



Assembly:

1. Sew (9) rail blocks together rotating each block as shown. Sew this unit to the left-hand side of the quilt top, noting orientation. Repeat this procedure for the right-hand side border. Repeat this procedure for the top and bottom borders using (11) rail blocks for each border.
2. Sew a 4-3/4" x 33-1/2" red/white print strip to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew a 4-3/4" x 42" red/white print strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Finishing:

Layer the finished quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind using the (5) 2-1/4" x 42" red bud print strips.

Bubblegum Blocks Quilt

Quilt Size: 67" x 84"

Materials You Will Need:

2-1/8 yards of a red print
1-1/2 yards of a blue/red dot
2-3/8 yards of a lime stripe, includes binding
5/8 yard of a pink stripe
1-3/4 yards of a white floral print
5-1/2 yards of backing fabric
75" x 92" piece of 60/40 Machine Blend Batting by Fairfield Processing Corp.

Cutting Directions:

From the red print, cut:

(12) 4-1/2" squares
(40) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces
(40) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces

From the lime stripe, cut:

(64) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces
(64) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces
(8) 2-1/4" x 42" strips for binding

From the blue/red dot, cut:

(20) 4-1/2" squares
(24) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces
(24) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces

From the pink stripe, cut:

(7) 2-1/2" x 42" strips

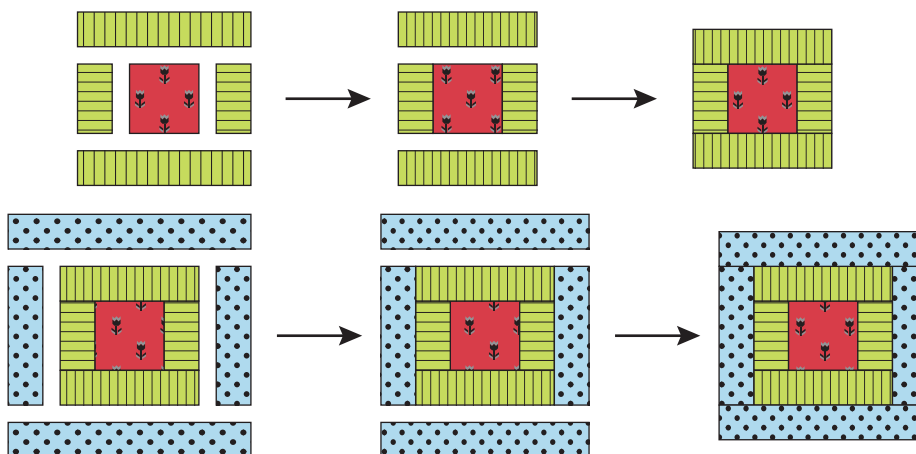
From the white floral print, cut:

(8) 6-1/2" x 42" strips

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

Making the Blocks:

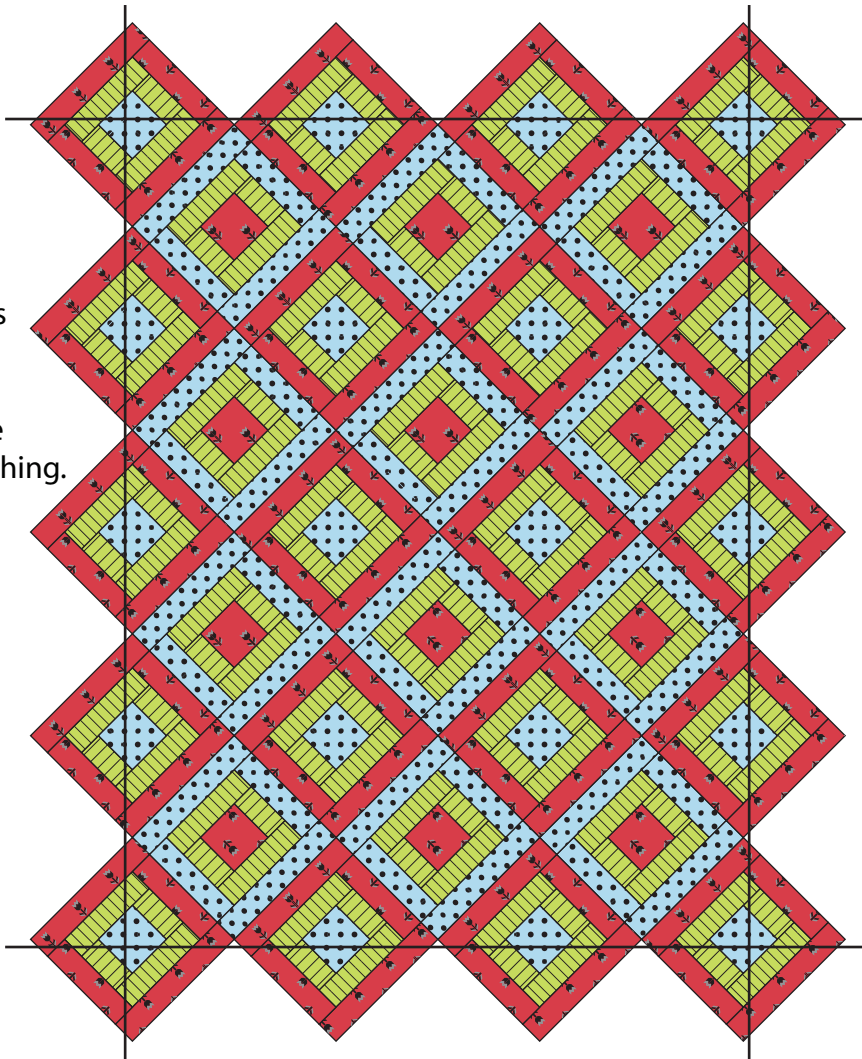
1. Sew a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" lime stripe piece to opposite sides of a 4-1/2" red print square. Sew a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" lime stripe piece to the top and bottom.
2. Sew a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" blue/red dot piece to opposite sides of the unit from step 1. Sew a 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" blue/red dot piece to the top and bottom to complete one red center box-in-a-box block.
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make a total of (12) red center box-in-a-box blocks. In the same way, make a total of (20) blue center box-in-a-box blocks.



Assembly:

1. Referring to the quilt photo, arrange the blocks into (8) diagonal rows, alternating the blocks as shown. Sew the blocks together into rows. Sew the rows of blocks together.

2. Trim the outer row of blue center blocks as shown, being careful to leave a 1/4" seam allowance on each edge. Stay stitch 1/8" in from the outer edge all around the quilt top to prevent the edges from stretching.



3. Sew the 2-1/2" x 42" pink stripe strips short ends together to make a long strip. Cut (2) 68-1/2" lengths and (2) 55-1/2" lengths. Sew the longer pieces to the sides of the quilt top. Sew the shorter pieces to the top and bottom.

4. Sew the 6-1/2" x 42" white floral strips short ends together to make a long strip. Cut (2) 72-1/2" lengths and (2) 67-1/2" lengths. Sew the longer pieces to the sides of the quilt top. Sew the shorter pieces to the top and bottom.

Finishing:

Layer the finished quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind using the 2-1/4" x 42" lime stripe strips.
