## Tree Pillow

### Materials You Will Need:

1/4 yard of a light cream tonal  
1/2 yard of a dark green leaf  
1/4 yard of a red/gold plaid  
1/4 yard of a medium red vine  
3/8 yard of a cream vine  
Scrap of a dark brown solid

### Cutting Directions:

From the light cream tonal, cut:

- (2) 1-1/2" squares
- (8) 2-1/2" squares
- (1) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" piece
- (2) 1-1/2" x 4" pieces
- (2) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces
- (2) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

From the dark green leaf, cut:

- (1) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" piece
- (1) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece
- (1) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece
- (1) 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" piece
- (2) 12" x 16-1/2" pieces

From the dark brown solid, cut:

- (1) 1-1/2" square

From the red/gold plaid, cut:

- (2) 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips
- (2) 2-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips

From the medium red vine, cut:

- (2) 2" x 13-1/2" strips
- (2) 2" x 16-1/2" strips

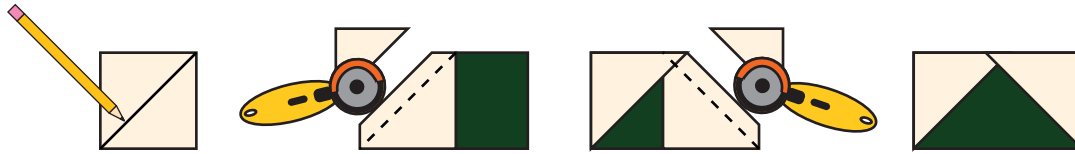
From the cream vine, cut:

- (3) 3" x 42" strips

# Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

## Making the Tree Pillow Front

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) 1-1/2" and (6) of the 2-1/2" light cream tonal squares. Place a marked 1-1/2" square, right sides together, on one end of a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" dark green leaf piece. Sew on the diagonal line, trim 1/4" beyond the drawn line, and press the corner open. In the same manner, add a 1-1/2" light cream tonal square to the other end of the dark green piece to make a Flying Geese unit, as shown.



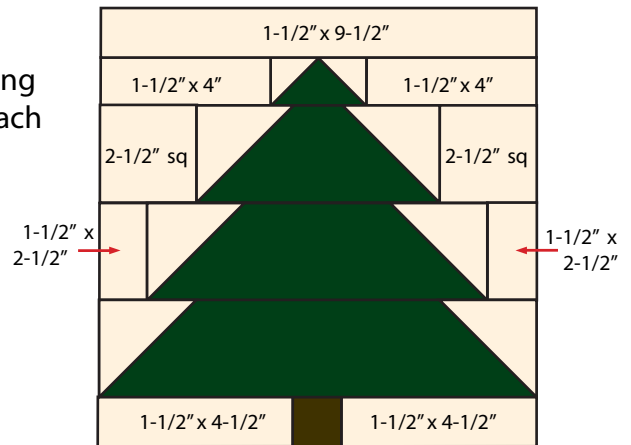
Making the Flying Geese units

2. In the same manner, make Flying Geese units by adding a 2-1/2" light cream tonal square to both ends of a 2-1/2" x 5-1/2", a 2-1/2" x 7-1/2", and a 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" dark green leaf piece, as shown. (Make 1 of each length.)

Refer to the Tree Block Diagram; lay out the light cream tonal pieces, as indicated, the 1-1/2" dark brown square, and the Flying Geese units, as shown, in (6) rows. Sew the units together in each row. Join the rows to make a Tree block.

3. Sew a 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" red/gold plaid strip to the sides of the tree block. Sew a 2-1/2" x 13-1/2" red/gold plaid strip to the top and bottom of the tree block.

4. Sew a 2" x 13-1/2" medium red vine strip to the sides of the tree block. Sew a 2" x 16-1/2" medium red vine strip to the top and bottom of the tree block.

## Star Pillow

### Materials You Will Need:

- 1/8 yard of a red snowflake print
- 1/8 yard of a green snowflake print
- 1/4 yard of a cream mottled
- 3/4 yard of a dark green leaf
- 3/8 yard of a cream vine

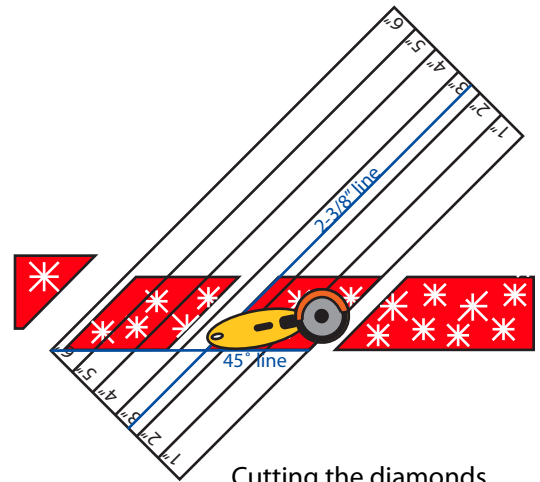
### Cutting Directions:

- From the red snowflake, cut:
  - (1) 2-3/8" x 42" strip
- From the green snowflake, cut:
  - (1) 2-3/8" x 42" strip
- From the cream mottled, cut:
  - (4) 3-1/8" squares
  - (1) 5" square, then cut in half diagonally twice to make (4) triangles
- From the dark green leaf, cut:
  - (2) 4" x 9-1/2" strips
  - (2) 4" x 16-1/2" strips
  - (2) 12" x 16-1/2" pieces
- From the cream vine, cut:
  - (3) 3" x 42" strips

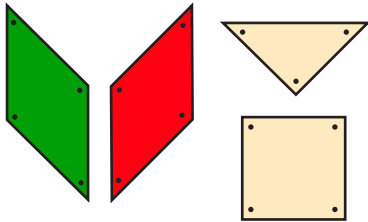
## Making the Star Pillow Front

### Cutting on the Diagonal

1. Using a 45° line on your ruler, trim one end of a 2-3/8" x 42" red snowflake strip at 45° to the long edge, and then cut pieces 2-3/8" wide to make a total of (4) diamonds. In the same manner, cut a total of (4) diamonds from a 2-3/8" x 42" green snowflake strip.



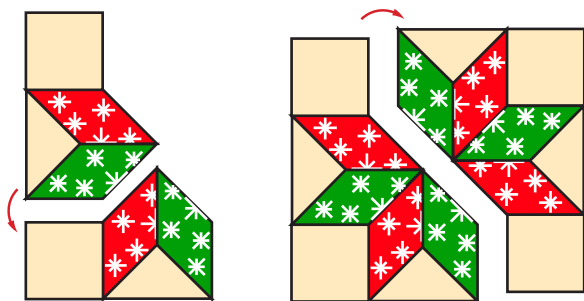
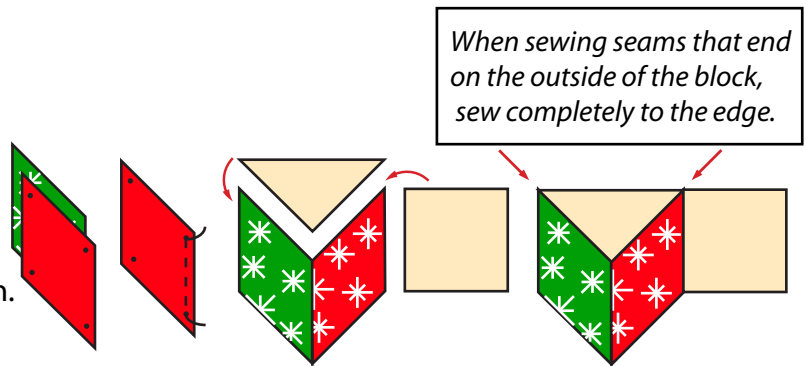
### Sewing a "Y" Seam



2. Mark the 1/4" seam allowance intersection on the wrong side of each corner with a dot, as shown. When stitching diamonds, triangles, and squares together, be sure to start and end each seam at the dot. Secure the seam by backstitching a couple of stitches at each corner.

### Assembling the Lemoyne Star

3. Sew a green diamond to a red diamond along one side. Aligning the dots, stitch a cream mottled triangle to the top of each diamond pair and a 3-1/8" cream mottled square to the right side of each diamond pair to make a quarter star section. (Make 4 quarter star sections.)



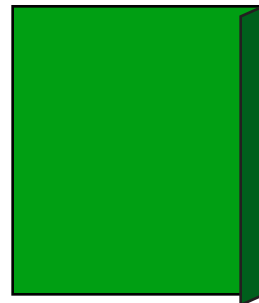
Sew (2) quarter star sections together, pivoting needle down at each corner to make a half star unit. In the same manner, sew (2) half star units together to complete a Lemoyne Star block.

3. Sew a 4" x 9-1/2" dark green leaf strip to the sides of the star block. Sew a 4" x 16-1/2" dark green leaf strip to the top and bottom of the star block.

## Adding the back and the ruffle to the pillow fronts

5. To make the ruffle, sew the short ends together on the (3) 3" x 42" cream vine strips. to make a long strip. Hem or surge one side of the long strip and run a gathering stitch along the other long side. Pin the ruffle to the pillow front with right sides together and raw edges even. Gather the stitches to fit the pillow front evenly. Baste the ruffle to the pillow front.

6. Hem (1) long side of each 12" x 16-1/2" dark leaf piece by turning 1" to the wrong side and press. Turn 1" a second time to make a double fold hem. Top stitch the hem in place.



7. Place the back pieces, right sides down, on the pillow front and the ruffle, overlapping the hemmed edges in the center. Sew all the way around the pillow through all the layers. Turn right side out and insert a 16" pillow form.
