Materials You Will Need: (Makes 2)

1-5/8 yards of a cream print
1/4 yard of a blue tonal
3/4 yard of a small blue stripe

Cutting Directions:

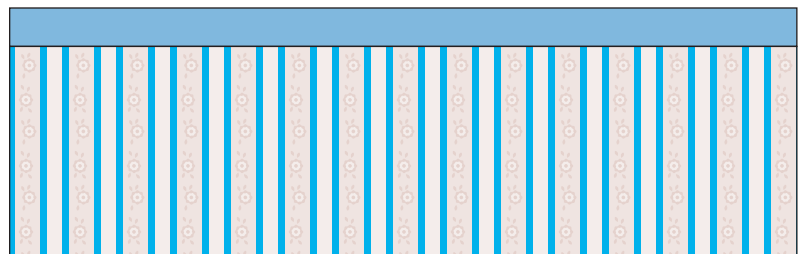
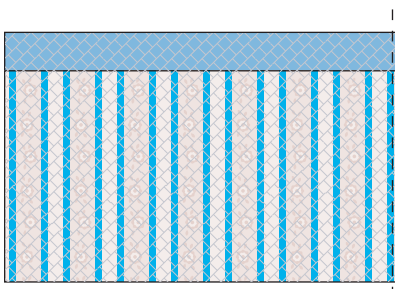
From the cream print, cut:
(2) 25-1/2" x 41" pieces

From the blue tonal, cut:
(2) 2" x 41" strips

From the small blue stripe, cut:
(2) 11" x 41" strips

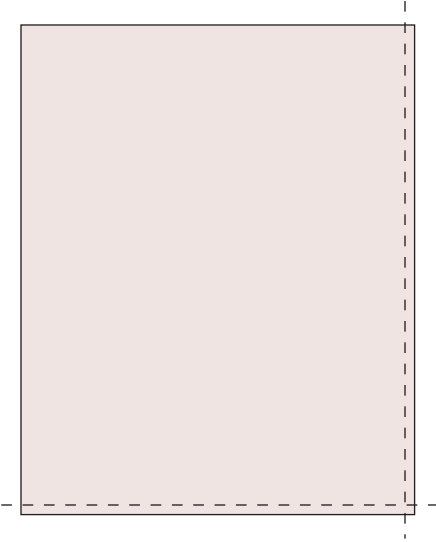
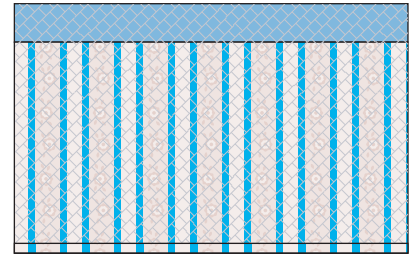
Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/2" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Stitch a 2" x 41" blue tonal strip lengthwise
to each of the 11" x 41" small blue stripe
strips. Press seam to blue print.

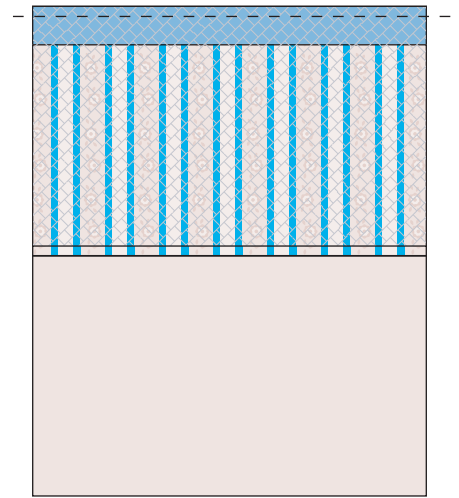


2. Fold the pieced strip right sides together and stitch together along
the short end. Press seam open.

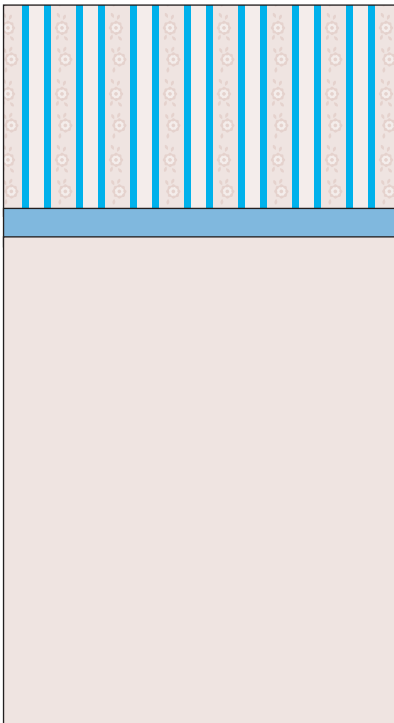
3. Turn the raw edge of the small blue stripe to wrong side 1/2" and press.



4. Fold the cream piece in half, right sides together, so it is 20-1/2" x 25-1/2". Stitch along the long edge and (1) short edge. Press seams open.

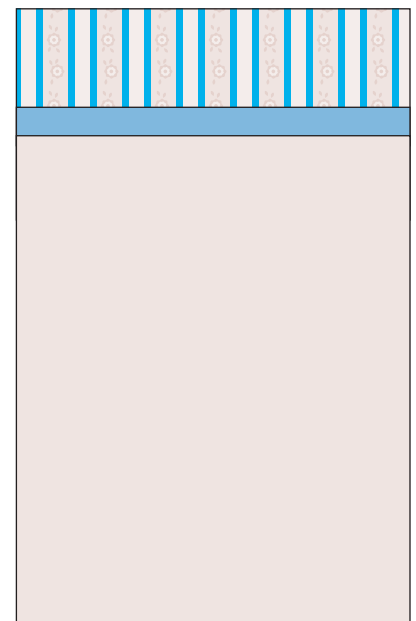


5. Turn the cream pillowcase base right sides out. Slide the cuff, still inside out, over the outside of the base with the blue edge even with the base top. With right sides together, matching the seams, pin the raw edges together. Stitch the layers together.



6. Press the cuff to the blue print.

Fold the cuff edge to the inside of the pillowcase so the 1/2" folded edge is 1/8" past the blue/cream seam allowance. Pin in place. From out the outside, stitch in the ditch on the cream fabric next the seam - catching the stripe fabric underneath. Stitch in the ditch along the other side of the blue strip.



7. Press pillowcase flat.
