



# Seaside Bath Shower Curtain, Tissue Box, and Towels

## Materials You Will Need:

- 3/4 yard of a white background fabric
- 4-1/8 yards of a red and blue seashells print
- 5/8 yard of a blue shells print
- 1/4 yard of a red shells print
- 1/3 yard of a blue tonal
- 1/2 yard of a red tonal
- 1/2 yard of a white/blue/red stripe
- 5-1/4 yards of a white flannel batting (prewash  
before cutting)
- 5-1/4 yards of a large red/blue floral for backing

## Cutting Directions:

### From the white background, cut:

#### SHOWER CURTAIN:

- (6) 5-1/4" squares, then cut in half diagonally twice to make (24) large triangles
- (12) 4-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (24) medium triangles
- (12) 2-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (24) small triangles

#### TOWEL #1:

- (4) 2-3/4" squares, then cut in half diagonally twice to make (16) medium triangles
- (8) 2-3/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (16) medium triangles
- (6) 1-5/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (12) small triangles

### From the red and blue seashells, cut:

#### SHOWER CURTAIN:

- (2) 49-1/2" x 38-1/2" pieces, cut lengthwise (match design with curtain bottom)
- (2) 12-1/2" x 38-1/2" pieces (match design with curtain top)
- (2) 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" pieces
- (1) 6-1/2" x 19" piece

#### TISSUE BOX:

- (1) 6-1/2" x 19" piece
- (2) 6-1/2" squares

**From the blue shells, cut:**

SHOWER CURTAIN:

(12) 4-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (24) medium triangles

TOWELS:

(8) 2-3/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (16) small triangles

TOWEL #1:

(2) 1-1/2" x 21" strips

TOWEL #2 AND TISSUE BOX:

(2) 3" x 21" strips

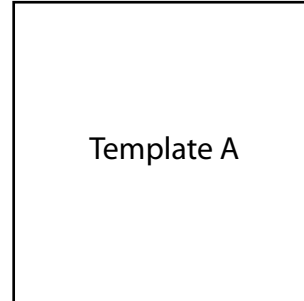
**From the red shells, cut:**

SHOWER CURTAIN:

(6) 3-3/8" squares

TOWEL #1:

(3) of Template A (squares)



**From the blue tonal, cut:**

SHOWER CURTAIN:

(6) 5-1/4" squares, then cut in half diagonally twice to make (24) large triangles

TOWEL #1:

(4) 2-3/4" squares, then cut in half diagonally twice to make (16) small triangles

**From the red tonal, cut:**

SHOWER CURTAIN:

(12) 4-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (24) medium triangles

(6) 2-3/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once to make (12) small triangles

TOWEL #2 AND TISSUE BOX:

(2) 1-3/4" x 21" pieces

**From the cream/blue/red stripe, cut:**

SHOWER CURTAIN:

(4) 2" x 42" strips

TISSUE BOX:

(1) 3-1/4" X 21" pieces

TOWEL #2:

(1) 3" x 21" piece

TOWEL #1:

(2) 3" x 21" pieces

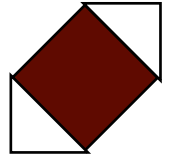
**From each of the white flannel batting and the large red/blue floral, cut:**

(2) 85" x 42" pieces

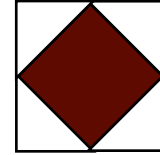
# Shower Curtain

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

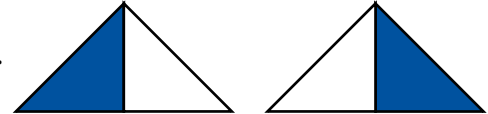
1. Sew a white 2-7/8" triangle to top and bottom of a 3-3/8" red shell square. Press. (Make 6)



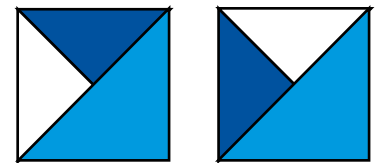
2. Sew a white 2-7/8" triangle to sides of red shell square. Press.



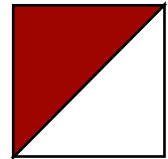
3. Sew a 5-1/4" blue tonal triangle to a 5-1/4" white triangle. Press. (Make 12 one way and 12 the opposite.)



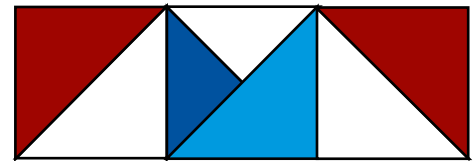
4. Sew a blue shell 4-7/8" triangle to triangles in step 3. Press. (Make 24)



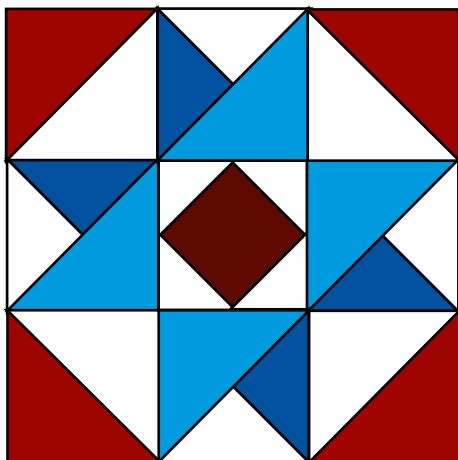
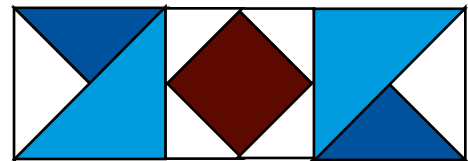
5. Sew a red tonal 4-7/8" triangle to a white 4-7/8" triangle. Press seams open. (Make 24)



6. Lay block out and sew a red and white triangle to blue and white square, then a red and white triangle. Press. (Make 12)



7. Sew a blue triangle square to center red square. Press. (Make 6)



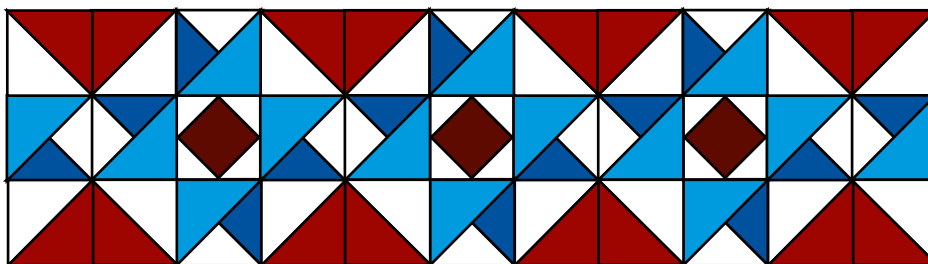
8. Sew block together and sew all six in a row.

9. Sew a 2" white/blue/red stripe strip together, lengthwise, twice. Press. Sew a strip to top and bottom of row of blocks. Trim and press.
10. Sew (2) 49-1/2" x 38-1/2" red and blue seashells strips together, matching design, press seams open. Sew to top of block strip.
11. Sew (2) 12-1/2" x 38-1/2" red and blue seashells strips together, matching design, press seams open. Sew to bottom of blocks. (Should measure 76-1/2" square)
12. Trim selvage and sew (2) strips of flannel together. Press seams open. Trim selvage, matching design, and sew (2) strips of large red/blue floral backing together. Press seams open.
13. Draw a 72" square on front of quilt. Layer quilt with flannel in the middle and quilt only in the 72" square area. Leave 3/4" free of quilting all the way around entire edge of quilt. Trim entire quilt to the 72-1/2" area.
14. Turn backing piece under and front piece back, being careful, and cut 1/2" of flannel away all the way around quilt. Press under 1/2" seam all the way around quilt. Press under 1/2" seam on back of quilt. Press. Top stitch all around quilt.

## Towel #1

### Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Make (3) full blocks the same as shower curtain. Also make (2) side sections for complete strip.



*(NOTE: To make a flange fold strip in half lengthwise and press. Sew (1) or (2) flanges together with 1/8" seam on raw edges.)*

2. Take both blue shell 1-1/2" x 21" strips and make a flange. Also make a flange with both white/blue/red stripe 3" x 21" strips. Sew both flanges together.
3. Sew flange to both sides of block strip with 1/4" seam. Press. Top stitch full strip to front of towel at the edge of blocks.

# Towel #2

## Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Pick a section of red and blue seashell out and iron fusable web to back. Cut out design and iron to towel. Zigzag with red thread around edges.
2. Take red tonal 1-3/4" x 21" strip and fold to make a bias strip. Press.
3. Take blue shell 3" x 21" strip and fold to make a bias strip. Press. Center and place red bias on top of blue bias and pin.
4. Fold a 3" x 21" white/blue/red stripe strip in half lengthwise and press. Sew a large gathering stitch 1/8" from edge. Hem ends of strip and gather strip.
5. Pin gathered strip to front of towel and sew down 1/8" on top of ruffle. Place (2) bias strips on top of ruffle making sure all raw edges of ruffle are covered. Top stitch both red and blue pieces down.

# Tissue Box

## Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Cover box with shell 6-1/2" x 19" piece. Cut out a cardboard for top and bottom of box. Cut hole for top. Also, cut a fat batting piece for top. Cover both top and bottom with shells material and glue to box.
2. With 1-3/4" red tonal strip make bias. Press. Fold bias in half lengthwise and glue to top of box.
3. Fold 3-1/4" strip of white/blue/red stripe to make bias. Fold in half and press.
4. Fold a 3" blue tonal under on both edges 1/4". Press. Fold in half and press.
5. Glue blue tonal strip to box bottom. Continue with white/blue/red stripe strip to finish box.
