Materials You Will Need: (Makes 2)

2 yards of a large floral print
1/2 yard of a brown/white dot
6 yards of 1/2" cording to cover
(2) 20" x 26" standard pillow forms

Cutting Directions:

From the large floral print, cut:
(2) 20-1/2" x 26-1/2" rectangles
(4) 20-1/2" squares

From the brown/white dot, cut:
(6) 2-1/2" x 42" strips

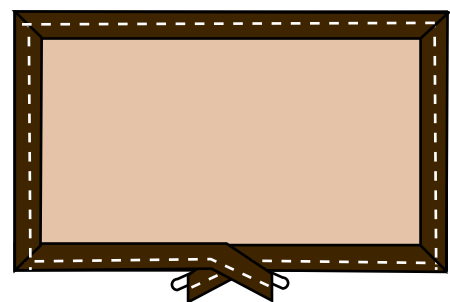
From the cording, cut:
(2) 3 yard pieces

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

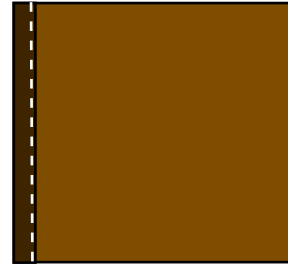
1. Sew the short ends together of (3) 2-1/2" x 42" brown/white dot strips to make a long strip. (Make 2 long strips.) Fold each long strip in half widthwise, wrong sides together, and press.
2. Place a 3 yard piece of cording into the center of the long strip. Using a zipper foot on your machine, sew the long strip, encasing the cording, as close as possible.



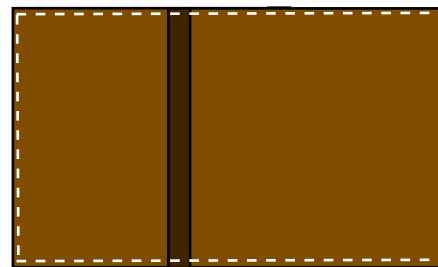
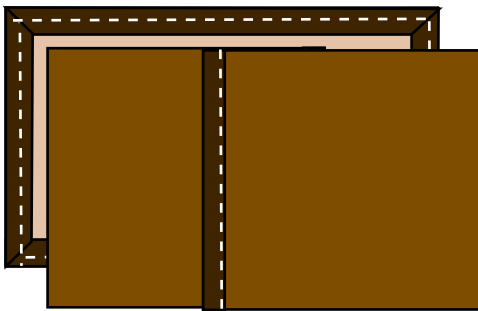
3. Starting on the bottom long edge, pin the cording to a 20-1/2" x 26-1/2" large floral rectangle, raw edges together. Sew, using a basting stitch, to hold in place.



4. Turn under 1" on one short side of each 20-1/2" large floral square and press. Turn under 1" again to make a double hem. Sew across the hem to make a back panel. (Make 4 back panels.)



5. Place (2) back panels, right sides together, on a pillow front with the hemmed edges in the center. The back panels will overlap.



6. Sew as close to the cording as possible around all four sides using the zipper foot. Turn the pillow sham right side out and press.
