

# Peekaboo Puppy Pillow

## Materials You Will Need:

1/3 yard of a brown tonal  
1/8 yard of a stripe print  
1/8 yard of a blue plaid print  
Scraps from a green circle print and a red plaid  
print for appliqués  
Batting scraps (optional)  
Fusible web  
12-15" of black No Iron Soutache Braid trim  
Fiberfil

## Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Using the template provided, cut (2) head shapes from the brown tonal. For a firmer pillow, cut one shape from the batting scraps as well.
2. Following manufacturer's instructions, iron the fusible web to the wrong side of the green circle and red plaid scraps. Choose (2) matching circles from the circle print and cut around each one for puppy eyes. Using the template provided, cut a star from the red plaid print for the nose. Using a zigzag stitch and invisible thread, stitch around each eye and the nose.
3. Place the black soutache braid under the nose to form a mouth, as shown. Pin in place and stitch using a zigzag stitch and invisible thread.
4. Using the template provided, cut (1) ear shape from the blue plaid. Flip the template upside down and cut a second ear shape from the blue plaid. In the same manner, cut two ear shapes from the stripe print. If desired, also cut two shapes from the batting scraps. Layer a batting ear, stripe print ear, and plaid print ear, with right sides of fabric facing. Stitch around three sides, leaving the bottom open for turning. Clip curves and turn right side out. Press and topstitch near the edge around the three closed sides. Make a second ear.
5. Pin the ears onto the puppy head front, about 1/2" to 3/4" from each corner, matching raw edges.
6. Layer the batting, puppy head front right side up, and puppy head back right side down. Make sure to move the pins for the ears to the outside so they don't get sewn into the pillow. Pin around the pillow, leaving a 3" opening for turning. Stitch around, clip curves and corners, and pull through the opening. Stuff with fiberfill and hand stitch the opening closed.
