Materials You Will Need: (Makes 1 sham)

3/4 yard of an exotic blooms print
1-1/3 yards of a blue tonal
(1) standard pillow form

Cutting Directions:

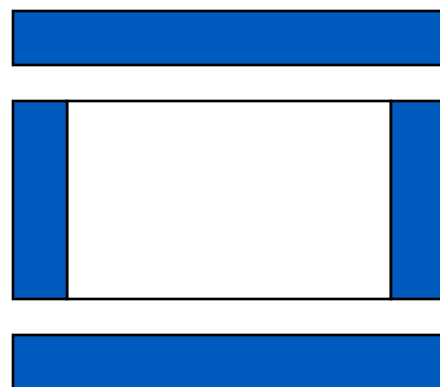
From the exotic blooms print, cut:
(1) 21" x 28" piece

From the blue tonal, cut:
(2) 21" x 28" pieces (for backing)
(2) 4-1/2" x 42" strips
(2) 4-1/2" x 21" strips

Sewing Directions:

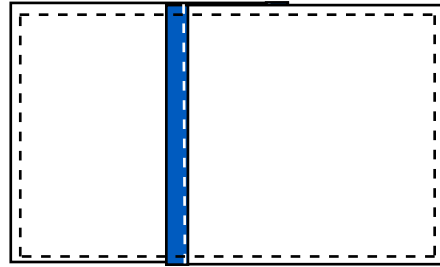
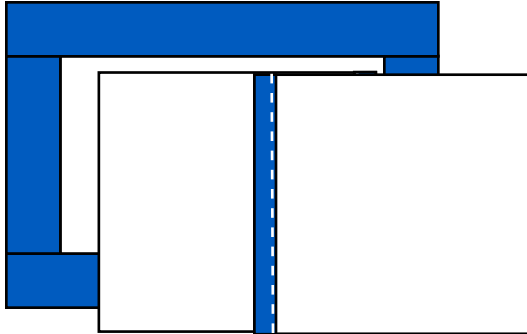
(Seam allowance is 1/2" unless stated otherwise)

1. Stitch a 4-1/2" x 21" blue tonal strip to opposite sides of 21" x 28" exotic blooms piece. Stitch 4-1/2" x 42" blue strips to the top and bottom of unit. Press and trim excess to finish pillow top.



2. On one long edge of a 21" x 28" backing piece, fold and press 1/4" to wrong side. Fold over again and press in place. Topstitch to finish hem. Repeat on the second back piece.

3. Lay the pillow top, right side up. Place a backing piece, right sides down, matching raw edges and positioning the hemmed edge in the middle of the pillow top. Pin in place. Position the second backing piece on the other side of the top, right sides down, matching raw edges and positioning the hemmed edge in the middle. Pin in place. Stitch with a 1/2" seam allowance around all outside edges. Press seams open as much as possible. Trim corners to no closer than 1/4".



4. Turn sham right sides out and push out corners. Press the edges flat. Stitch in the ditch, through all layers, around the center floral panel to create a flange. Insert pillow form.
