Materials You Will Need:

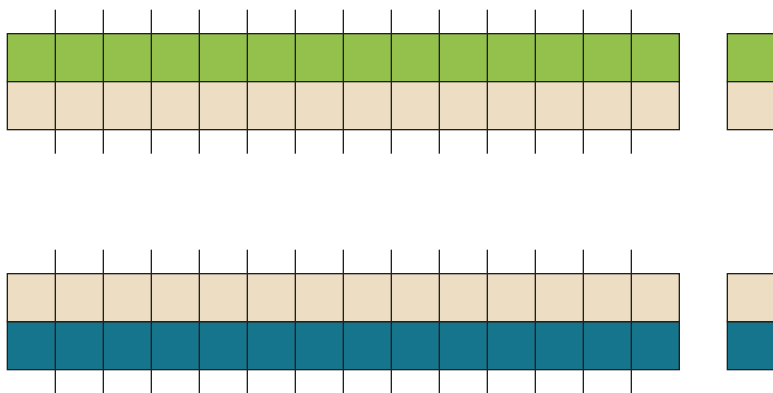
1/2 yard of a light green swirl
1/3 yard of a dark blue swirl
1-1/8 yards of a cream tonal
5/8 yard of a yellow swirl
5/8 yard of a dark green swirl
1-1/4 yards of a yellow large floral,
includes binding
3-1/2 yards of backing fabric
58" square piece of batting

Cutting Directions:

Light Green Swirl	Yellow Swirl
(3) 2-3/4" x 42" strips	(16) 5-3/8" squares
(20) 2-1/2" squares	
Dark Blue Swirl	Dark Green Swirl
(3) 2-3/4" x 42" strips	(2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips
	(3) 2-1/2" x 42" strips
	(4) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces
Cream Tonal	Yellow Large Floral
(6) 2-3/4" x 42" strips	(4) 6-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips
(16) 5-3/8" squares	(6) 2-1/4" x 42" strips for binding
(16) 2-1/2" squares	

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Sew each 2-3/4" x 42" light green swirl strip lengthwise to a 2-3/4" x 42" cream tonal strip. From these (3) strip sets, crosscut a total of (32) 2-3/4" wide four-patch segments. Repeat with the (2) 2-3/4" x 42" dark blue swirl strips and (2) 2-3/4" x 42" cream tonal strips.



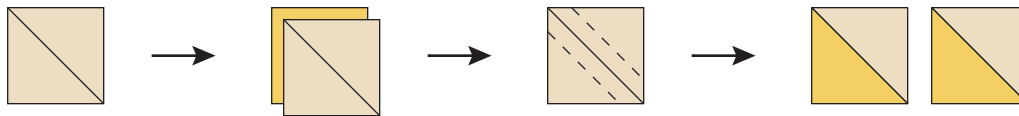
MAKING THE FOUR-PATCH SEGMENTS

2. Sew a light green/cream segment to a dark blue/cream segment to make a four-patch unit. Make a total of (32) four-patch units.



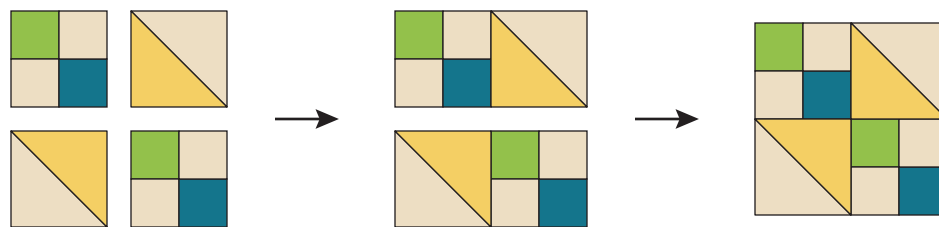
MAKING A FOUR-PATCH UNIT

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 5-3/8" cream tonal square. Layer a marked square right sides together with a 5-3/8" yellow swirl square. Sew 1/4" from either side of the marked line, cut on the line, and press the pieces open to create (2) half-square triangle units.

4. Noting orientation, lay out (2) four-patch units and (2) half-square triangle units. Sew the units together to form a block. Make a total of (16) blocks.



MAKING A BLOCK

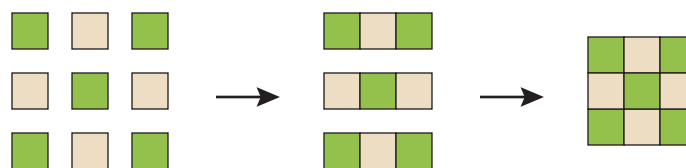
ASSEMBLY

1. Lay out the blocks into (4) rows of (4) blocks each. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows.

2. Sew a 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" dark green swirl strip and a 6-1/2" x 36-1/2" yellow large floral strip to opposite sides of the quilt.

3. Sew (3) 2-1/2" x 42" dark green swirl strips short ends together to make one long strip. Cut two 52-1/2" lengths and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

4. To make a corner nine-patch block, lay out (5) 2-1/2" light green swirl squares and (4) 2-1/2" cream tonal squares as shown. Sew the squares into rows and join the rows. Make a total of (4) nine-patch blocks.

5. Sew a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" dark green swirl piece and a nine-patch block to both ends of the remaining 6-1/2" x 36-1/2" yellow large floral strips. Sew these pieced strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

FINISHING

Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting and quilt as desired. Use the (5) 2-1/4" x 42" yellow large floral strips to bind the quilt.
