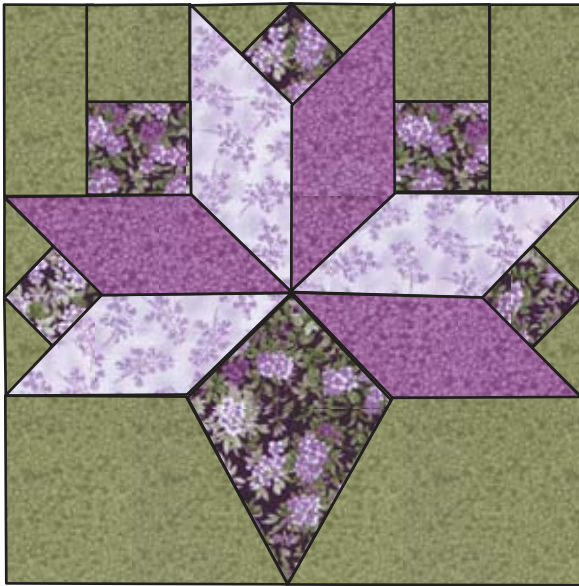


Fabric Stash Blocks

PLEASE NOTE: This fabric stash block first appeared in the Oct/Nov 2007 issue of QUILT magazine. Many fabrics have a shelf life of about 6 months to 1 year. These exact fabrics may not still be available for purchase. Take heart! Your favorite quilt shop can help you select suitable substitutes in colors and patterns that will work just as well to make this block.





CORNUCOPIA - 12"


Perhaps no other symbol is associated with Thanksgiving more than a Cornucopia. This just happens to be the name of a traditional quilting block, so I had to make it my choice for the Thanksgiving season. The intermediate pattern uses beautiful colors reminiscent of the grapes that often grace a "Horn of Plenty" I chose fabrics from the Kensington Gardens fabric line by P&B Textiles. www.pbtex.com

A  Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" medium green print rectangles



B   Cut (2) 2-1/2" purple floral print squares
Cut (2) 2-1/2" medium green print squares

C  Cut (2) 3-1/4" medium green print squares, then cut diagonally twice to make (8) triangles.
(You will use 6 for the block)

D  Cut (3) 1-7/8" purple floral print squares

E  Cut (1) Template A of medium green print
Cut (1) Template A reversed of medium green print

F  Cut (1) Template B of purple floral print

G   Cut (3) Template C of medium purple print
Cut (3) Template C of light purple print
