Materials You Will Need:

- 2-3/4 yards of a large gold floral
- 1-5/8 yards of a natural tonal, includes binding
- 1 yard of a gold tonal
- 2 yards of a small purple floral
- 1/3 yard of a small pink floral
- 1-1/8 yards of a green tonal
- 1/3 yard of a red tonal
- 1-1/4 yards of a natural floral stripe
- 3/4 yard of a natural dot for binding
- 5 yards of backing fabric
- 90" square of batting

Cutting Directions:

From the large gold floral, cut:
(40) 8-1/2" squares

From the natural tonal, cut:
(164) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

From the gold tonal, cut:
(164) 2-1/2" squares

From the small purple floral, cut:
(328) 2-1/2" squares
(4) 4-1/2" squares

From the small pink floral, cut:
(41) 2-1/2" squares

From the green tonal, cut:
(82) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces
(82) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces
(16) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces
(4) 1-1/2" squares

From the red tonal, cut:
(20) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces

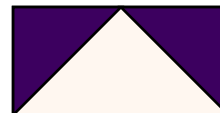
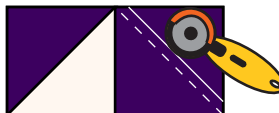
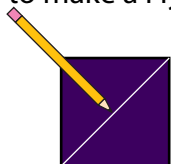
From the natural floral stripe, cut:
(8) 4-1/2" x 42" strips

From the natural dot, cut:
(9) 2-1/2" x 42" strips for binding

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

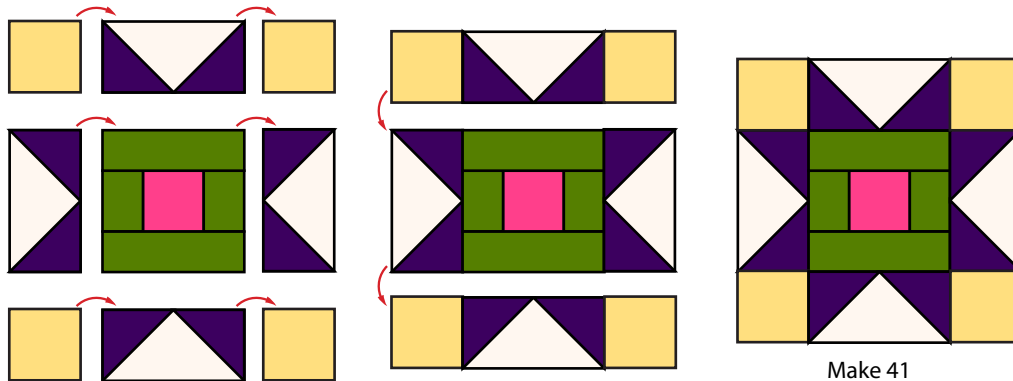
Making the Star Block

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (328) small purple floral squares. Place a marked square on the end of (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" natural tonal piece. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the corner and press open. In the same manner, sew a second marked square on the opposite end of the natural tonal piece. Trim the corner and press open to make a Flying Geese unit. (Make 164 units.)

Sew (2) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" green tonal pieces to opposite sides of the 2-1/2" small pink floral square. Sew (2) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" green tonal pieces to the top and bottom of the small pink floral square. Refer to Assembling the Star Block; lay out the pink and green square, (4) Flying Geese units, and (4) 2-1/2" gold tonal squares in (3) rows of (3) units each. Sew the units together in each row. Join the rows to make a Star block. (Make 41 Star blocks.)

Assembling the Quilt

Refer to the quilt photo; lay out the (41) Star blocks and the (40) 8-1/2" large gold floral squares in (9) rows of (9) blocks each. Sew the blocks together in each row. Join the rows.

Borders

First Border

Stitch (4) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" green tonal pieces alternating with (5) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" red tonal pieces to make a long border strip. (Make 4) Sew (2) border strips to opposite sides of the quilt. Stitch a 1-1/2" green tonal square to each end of the remaining (2) border strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Second Border

Sew the short ends of (8) 4-1/2" x 42" natural floral stripe strips together to make a long strip. Crosscut the long strip into (4) 74-1/2" border strips. Stitch a border strip to the sides of the quilt. Stitch a 4-1/2" small purple floral square to each end of the remaining (2) border strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Finishing

Refer to the General Directions for backing, quilting, and binding; use the (9) 2-1/2" x 42" natural dot strips to bind the quilt.
