

Playing Checkers Bag

Materials You Will Need:

3/8 yard of a blue circle or green circle animal print
3/4" x 24" piece of ribbon (for bag)

Cutting Directions:

From the blue or green animal print, cut:
(1) 11-1/2" x 18-1/2" piece

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

MAKING THE BAG

1. Fold over 1/4" along each 11-1/2" side and topstitch to create a finished edge.
2. Fold the top edge down 1-1/2" along the long side and press. Sew 1/4" down from the fold through both layers of fabric.
3. Position the ribbon under the folded fabric. Sew through both layers of fabric under the ribbon to create a channel for the draw string.

4. Fold the bag fabric in half, right sides together so the ribbon ends from each side touch, and tuck the ribbons into the center. Sew across the bottom of the bag and up the side. Make sure not to sew through the ribbon channel.

5. Turn the bag right side out and press.
