## Materials You Will Need:

### Pillow

1 small scene from 24" x 44" panel piece  
1/4 yard of a yellow/red dot  
1/2 yard of a red plaid  
Fiberfill

### Book

5 small scenes from 24" x 44" panel piece  
1/4 yard of a green dot  
1/4 yard of a red plaid  
1/2 yard of batting

## Cutting Directions:

### Pillow

From the panel, cut:  
(1) 6" x 8" fussy cut piece

From the yellow/red dot, cut:  
(2) 3" x 6" pieces  
(2) 3" x 13" pieces

From the red plaid, cut:  
(1) 14" X 16" piece for backing  
(2) 2" x 11" pieces  
(2) 2" x 16" pieces

### Book

From the panel, cut:  
(5) 6" x 8-1/2" fussy cut pieces

From the green dot, cut:  
(1) 6" x 8-1/2" piece

From the red plaid, cut:  
(1) 6" x 16" piece

From the batting, cut:  
(2) 6" x 16" pieces

# Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

## MAKING THE PILLOW

1. Sew 3" x 6" yellow/red dot pieces to opposite sides of the 6" x 8" fussy cut scene. Sew 3" x 13" yellow/red dot pieces to the top and bottom.
2. Sew 2" x 11" red plaid pieces to the sides of the unit from step 1. Add 2" x 16" pieces to the top and bottom.
3. Layer the pillow front right sides together with the 14" x 16" red plaid backing piece. Stitch around three sides. Stuff with the fiberfill and whipstitch the opening closed.
4. Stitch in the ditch between the yellow/red dot and red plaid strips to create an outer pillow flange.

## MAKING THE BOOK

1. Sew (2) 6" x 8-1/2" fussy cut pieces together along one short side. Repeat with (2) additional fussy cut pieces. Sew the 6" x 8-1/2" green dot piece to the remaining fussy cut piece in the same manner.
2. Layer (2) fussy cut pieced units from step 1 right sides together and position a 6" x 16" piece of batting on top. Stitch around all sides, leaving an opening for turning. Turn right sides out and whipstitch the opening closed.
3. Repeat step 2, layering the green dot/fussy cut pieced unit right sides together with a 6" x 16" red plaid piece.
4. Lay the unit from step 3 red plaid side down. Position the unit from step 2 on top. Stitch down the seam line in the middle to create the book "spine."
