Web Bonus pattern for napkins by Kelley Walton

Materials You Will Need: (Makes 2 napkins)

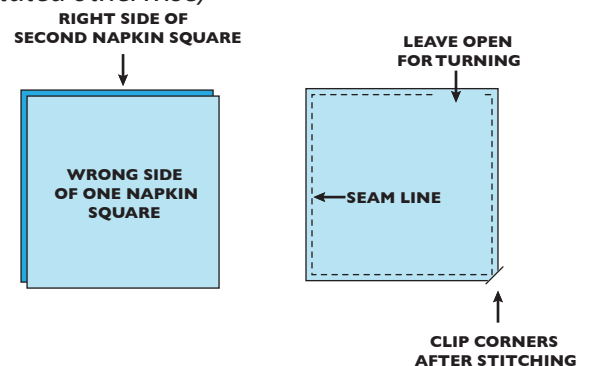
1/2 yard each of (2) various prints
Coordinating threads

Cutting Directions:

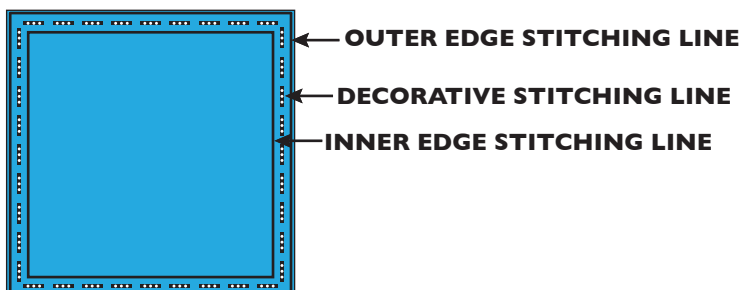
From each of the various prints, cut:
(2) 16-1/2” squares

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4” unless stated otherwise)*

Place (2) 16-1/2” squares, right sides together, and stitch around, all four sides leaving a 4” opening for turning. Clip corners and turn right side out. Pull out corners and press well.



Using a coordinating thread, topstitch all the way around the napkin as close to the outer edge as possible, closing the opening. If desired, choose a decorative stitch and stitch 1/4” from the edge stitching. Then, edge stitch again with a straight stitch 1/4” from the decorative stitching. (Make 2 napkins.)



(Note: You may make the front and back of each napkin from the same fabric or use different fabrics for the front and back of each napkin for a more whimsical look.)
