## Materials You Will Need:

1/8 yard of a black floral stripe  
1/8 yard of a black daisy print  
1/8 yard of a pink daisy print  
3-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece of fusible fleece

## Cutting Directions:

BLACK FLORAL STRIPE  
(2) 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces

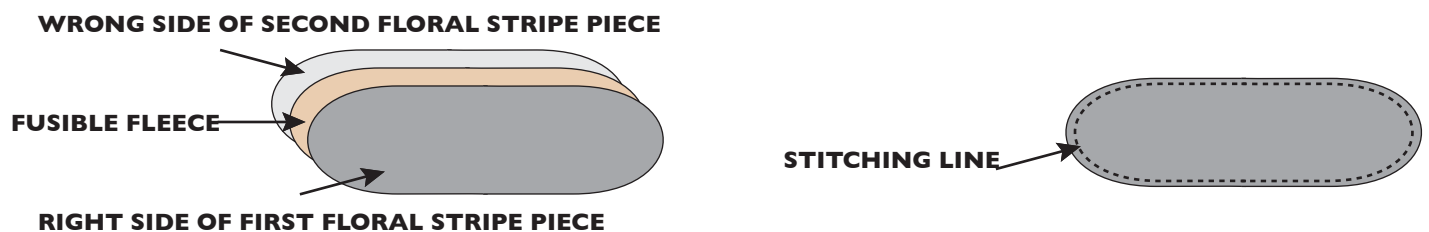
BLACK DAISY  
(1) 3-1/8" X 12" piece

PINK DAISY  
32" total of 2"-wide bias strips

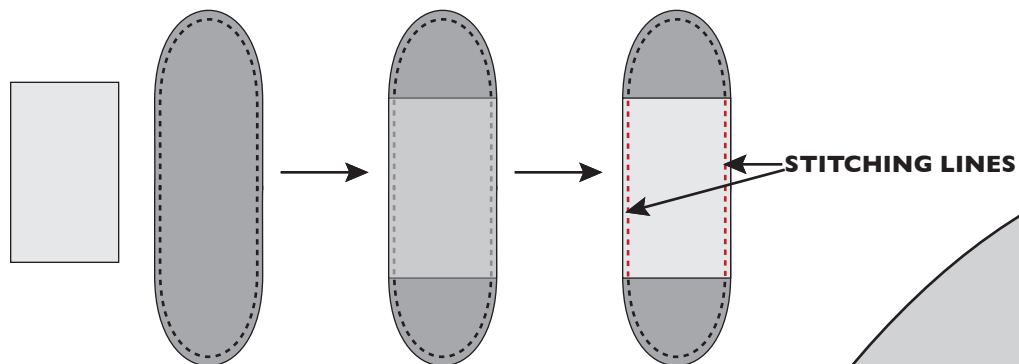
## Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

### MAKING THE SHOULDER STRAP PAD

1. Trace the pad template onto each 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" floral stripe piece and the fusible fleece. Cut out each shape on the traced line. Layer the shapes as shown and fuse together. Sew around the shape 1/4" from the outer edge.



2. Fold the 3-1/8" x 12" black daisy piece in half widthwise, wrong sides together, and sew across the short end. Turn right sides out. Pin over center of unit from step 1 as shown and stitch in place.



3. Piece bias strips together to form a long strip. Bind raw edges of shoulder pad. Thread your strap through the pad and enjoy the comfort!!
