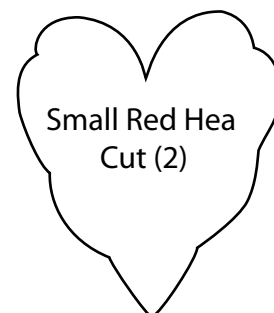


Materials You Will Need: (Makes 2)

1/2 yard of a light pink print
Scraps of a dark red print and a white sprinkle print
Double sided fusible webbing
Template plastic
Thread to match pink fabric
Threads for appliqué

Cutting Directions:

From the light pink print, cut:
(2) 14-1/2" squares



Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

SEWING:

Turn under 1/8" twice all the way around the outer edge of each napkin. Stitch close to the edge with matching thread to complete the hem of each napkin.

PREPARATION:

Using template plastic, make templates for both the heart and scallop shapes. Trace (2) heart motifs and (2) scallop motifs onto the wrong side of the fusible web leaving at least 1/2" space between motifs. Cut out each motif roughly 1/4" beyond the traced lines. Following manufacturer's directions, fuse each heart shape to the wrong side of the dark red fabric and each scallop shape to the wrong side of the white sprinkle print. Cut out each motif on the traced line.

APPLIQUÉ:

Layer a red heart motif on top of a scallop motif and place the motifs in one corner of a hemmed pink napkin. Use the picture shown as a guide to correct placement. Fuse the motifs in place and stitch over the raw edges of each motif using a decorative stitch.
