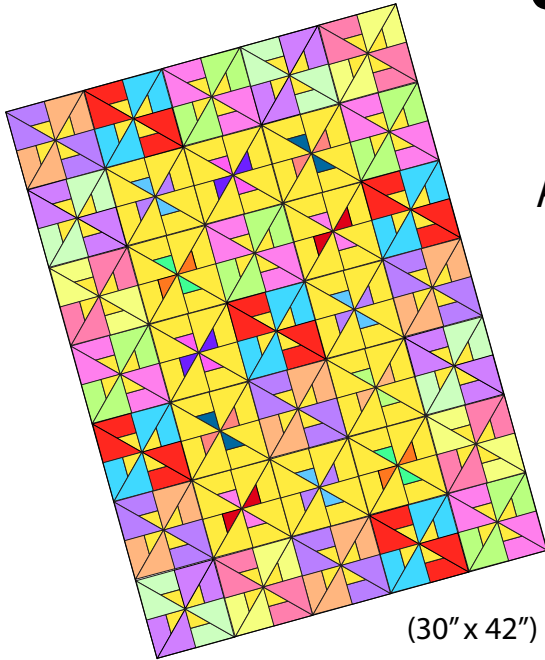


Sweet Baby Dreams Travel Baby Quilt

Materials You Will Need:

1/4 yard each of (12) assorted prints
1-1/4 yards of a bright yellow solid
3/8 yard of a light green solid for binding
1-3/8 yards of backing fabric
36" x 48" piece of batting
Template plastic

Cutting Directions:

From each of the (12) assorted prints, cut:
(4) 3-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once
to make (8) triangles
(1) 2-1/4" x 42" strips

From the bright yellow solid, cut:
(24) 3-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once
to make (48) triangles
(12) 2-1/4" x 42" strips

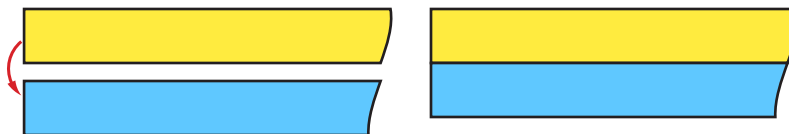
From the light green solid, cut:
(4) 2-1/4" x 42" strips for binding

From the template plastic, cut:
(1) Template A triangle

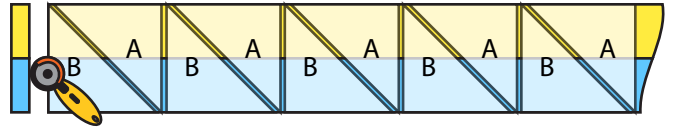
Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Cutting the A and B Triangles

Sew (1) 2-1/4" x 42" bright yellow strip to (1) 2-1/4" x 42" assorted print strip to make a two-strip panel.
Make a total of (12) two-strip panels.



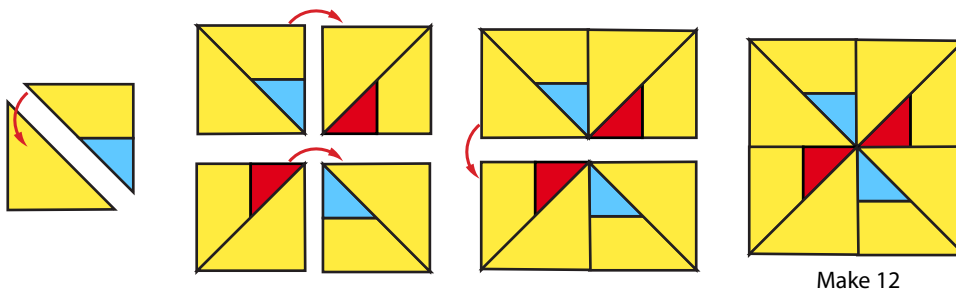
Lay the a two-strip panel on a flat surface with the yellow strip at the top. Line up template A with the bottom of the print strip and trim the left edge. Cut out a B triangle. Flip the template 180° and cut an A triangle. Continue cutting triangles for a total of (6) A triangles and (8) B triangles. In the same manner, cut A and B triangles from each two-strip panel.



2. Assembling the Yellow Blocks

Sort the (60) A triangles and (48) bright yellow triangles into (12) block piles. Each pile will include (4) bright yellow triangles, (2) A triangles with assorted print #1, and (2) A triangles with assorted print #2. (Note: There are extra A triangles to allow more color choices in your design.)

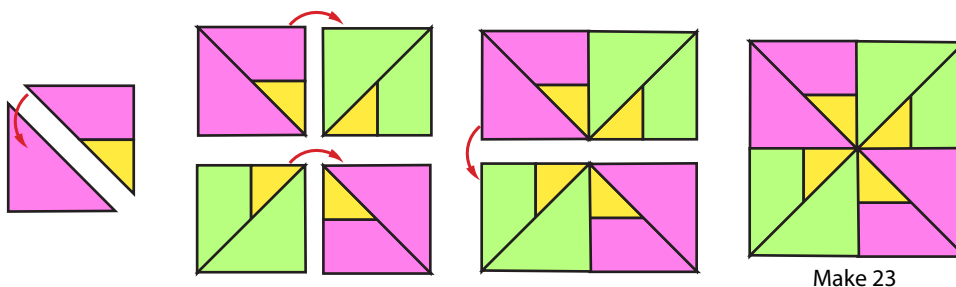
For each block pile, stitch the long side of a bright yellow triangle to the long side of (1) A triangle to make a 3-1/2" pinwheel unit. (Make 4) Lay out the (4) pinwheel units in (2) rows of (2) units each with like prints on opposite sides, as shown. Sew the units together in each row. Join the rows to make a yellow block. (Make 12 blocks.)



3. Assembling the Assorted Print Blocks

Sort (96) B triangles and (96) assorted print triangles into (23) block piles. Each pile will include (2) assorted print triangles #1, (2) assorted print triangles #2, (2) B triangles with assorted print #1, and (2) B triangles with assorted print #2.

For each block pile, stitch the long side of an assorted print triangle to the long side of (1) B triangle to make a 3-1/2" pinwheel unit. (Make 4) Lay out the (4) pinwheel units in (2) rows of (2) units each with like prints on opposite sides, as shown. Sew the units together in each row. Join the rows to make an assorted print block. (Make 23 blocks.)



4. Assembling the Quilt

Refer to quilt photo; lay out the yellow and assorted print blocks in (7) rows of (5) blocks each. Sew the blocks together in each row. Join the rows.

5. Finishing

Quilt as desired and use the (7) 2-1/4" x 42" light green solid strips to bind the quilt.
